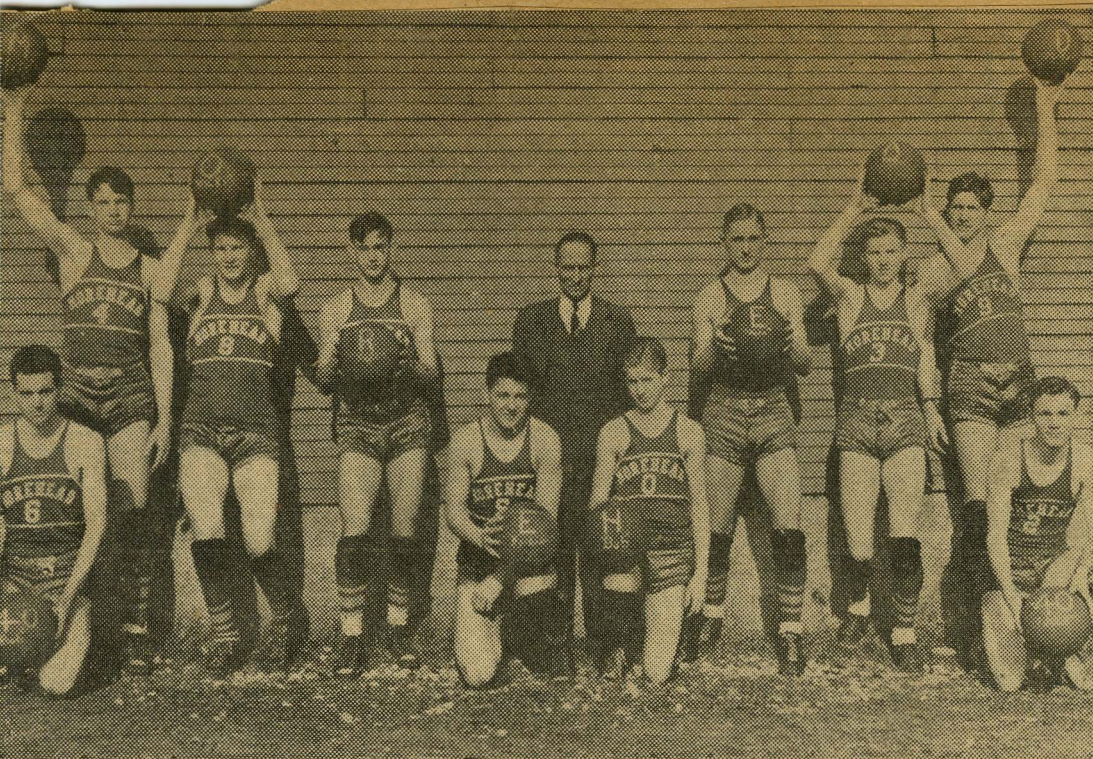

Pairings For 64th Are Made

Ashland, Ky., Feb. 9.—With no games of major importance scheduled for the first of the week in this area, fans are busy speculating on the 64th District drawings, which were made here Sunday by the ten competing schools.

For the first time in history, the top-ranking teams were seeded and cannot meet until the semi-finals. Catlettsburg, currently ranked No. 9 in the Ashland Independent's pool for Associated Press papers, was top-seeded with Ashland Holy Family second, Ashland third and Raceland fourth. Catlettsburg has defeated Raceland twice, Holy Family twice and Ashland once.

Catlettsburg (21-3) is in the top bracket and pitted against South Portsmouth (14-8) in the first round. The winner will tackle McKell (3-7) then meet the winner of the game between Raceland (11-4) and Wurtland (0-7).

Holy Family (14-4) goes against Russell (4-12) in the lower bracket with Ashland (10-6) meeting Greenup (10-10). Boyd County (6-8) will play the winner of the Holy Family-Russell tilt.

OFFICIALS

Ashland and Ashland Holy Family are not scheduled during the regular season.

Charles Ramey, tournament manager, was instructed to secure Edgar McNabb and Warren Cooper to officiate if they are available. Mrs. Norma Calhoun will be the official scorer and Charles Stewart the timer.

All sessions are expected to be complete sellouts, and radio broadcast will be permitted. The tourney starts Wednesday night, March 3, and will continue Thursday night, Friday night, Saturday afternoon and Saturday night. There will be a game to determine third place.

Tickets for advance sale will be allotted each school as long as they remain in the running.

In the voting to seed the teams, Catlettsburg received seven first places with Holy Family getting two and Ashland one.

E. K. C. MEET

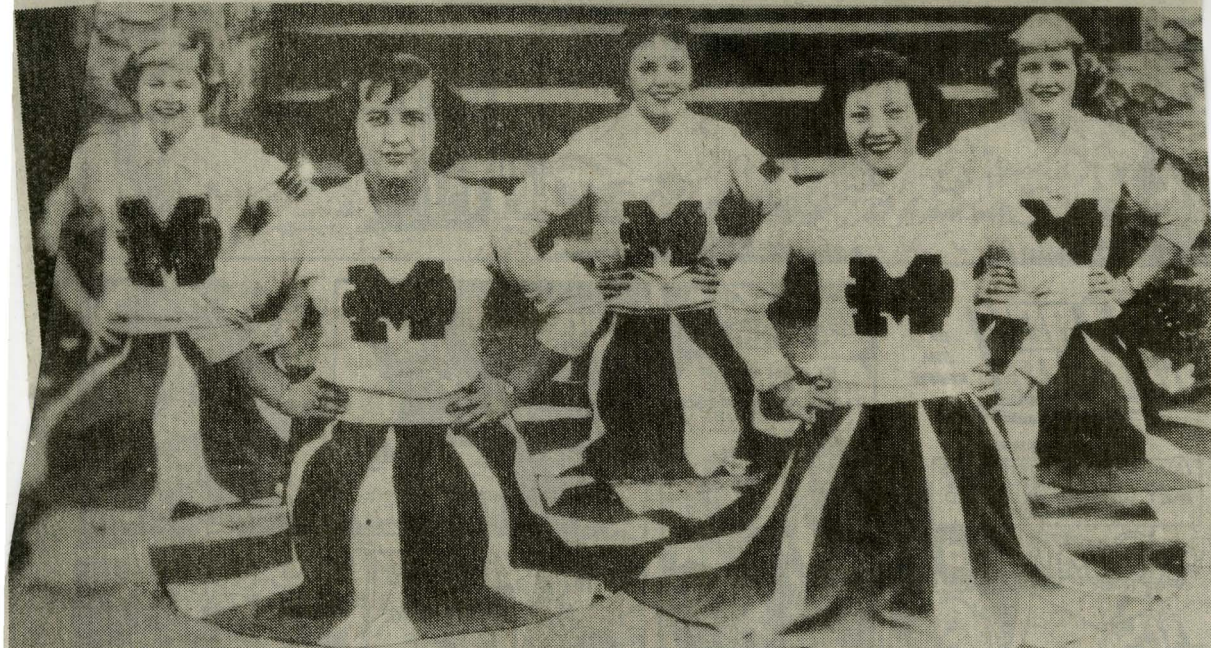

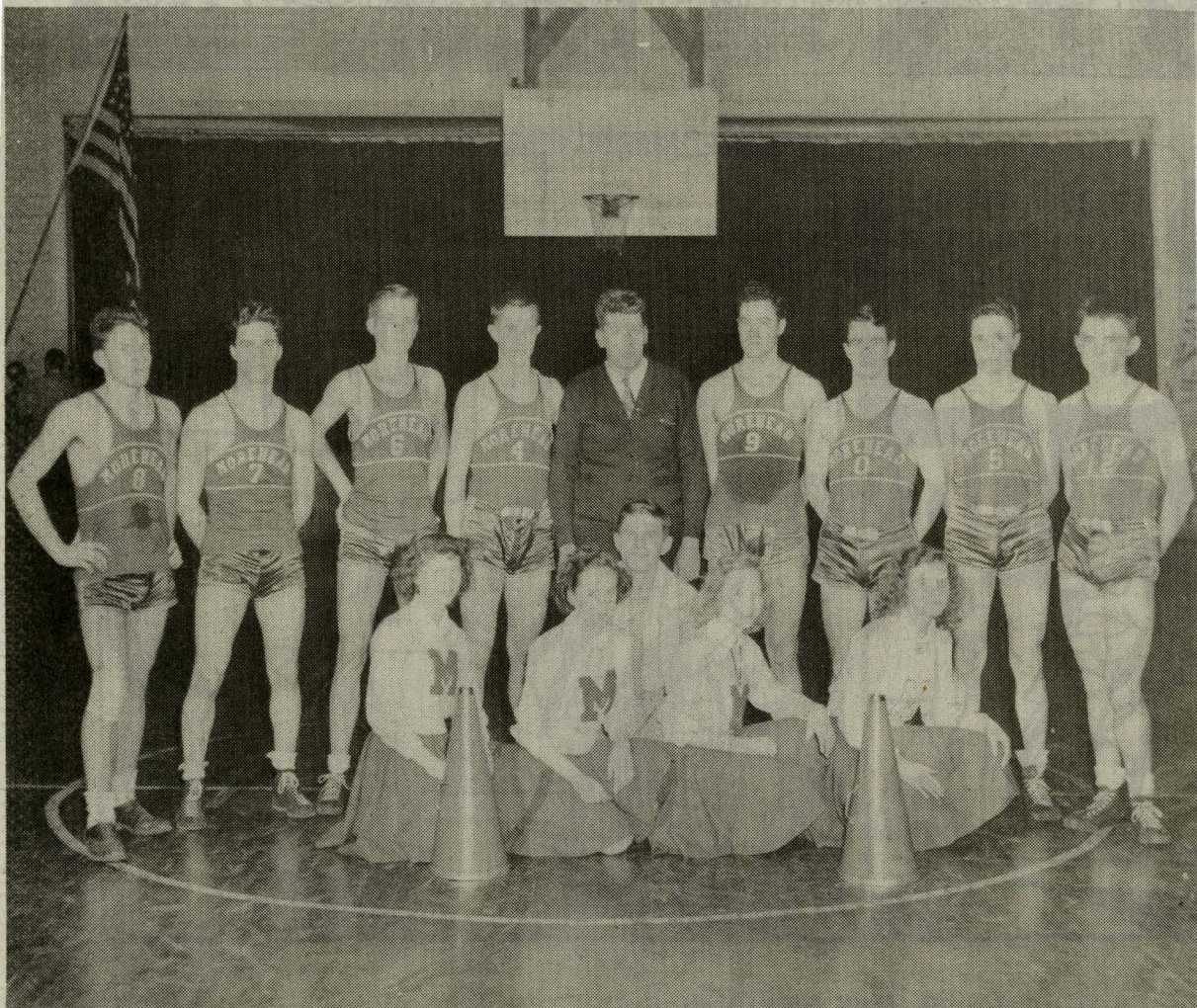

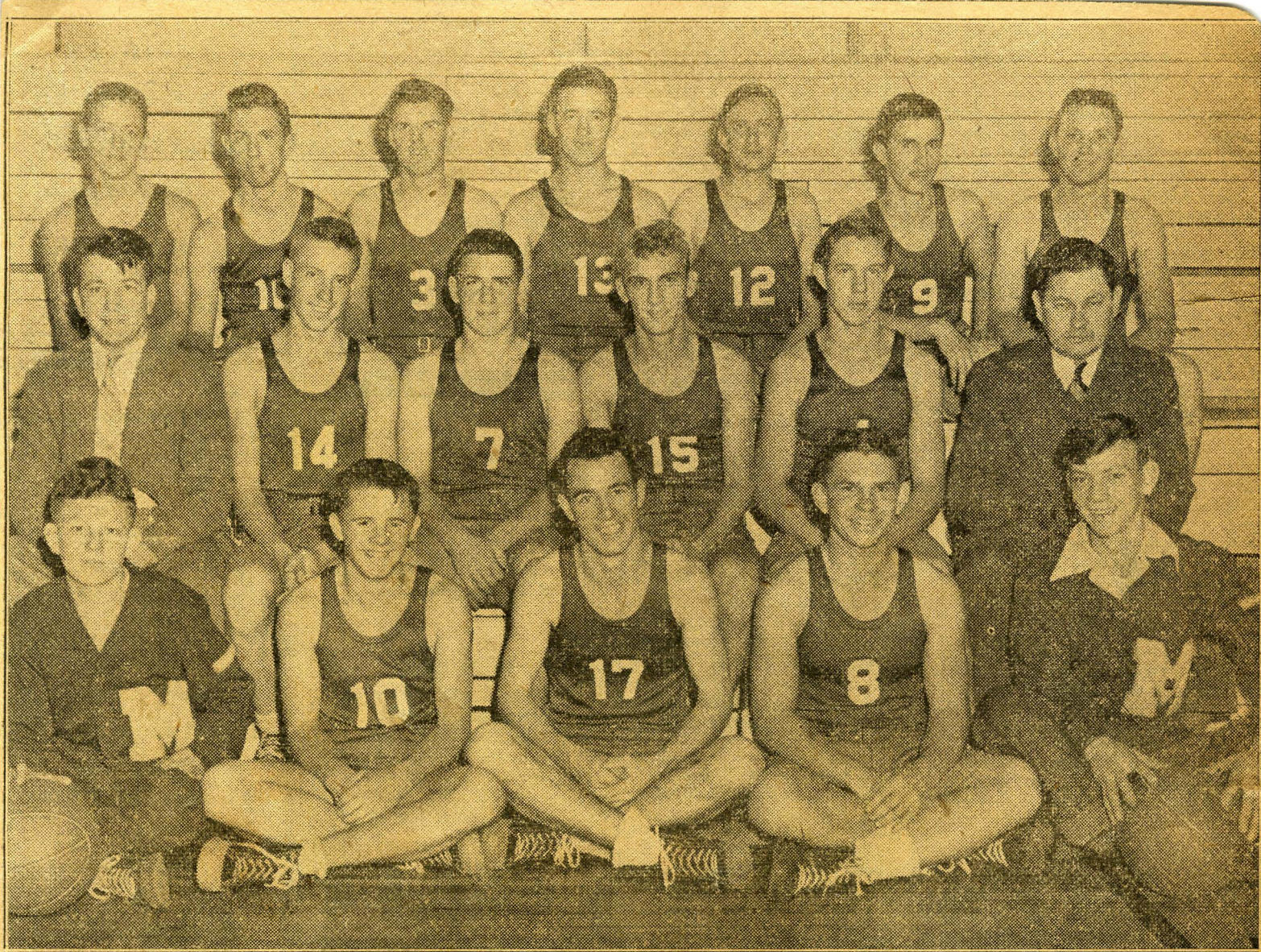
