

Hi Sailor!

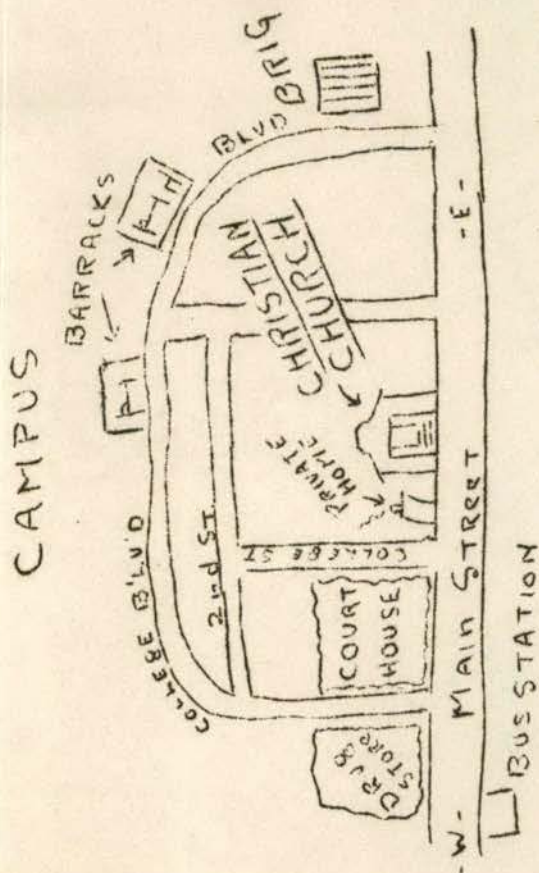
I'd like a date with you! Been watching you for sometime and wishing I knew you. Let's get acquainted!

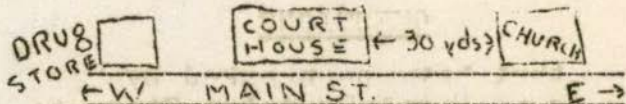

Q: Where is the Christian Church?
Ans: On Main Street, 30 yards east of the Court House



Q: Is it a Christian Scientist Church?

Q: What kind of a Church is it?
Ans:
