

—The grand jury of Rowan county on Monday found true bills against Henry S. Logan, Morgan McClury and Lou Rayburn for conspiracy to kill Judge A. E. Cole, Col. Z. T. Young and his son, Allie W. Young, now county attorney of Rowan. The scheme was detected by the arrest of James A. Harris, alias Pendleton, a suspicious character, who afterwards disclosed the plot, saying that Henry S. Logan had hired McClury, Rayburn and two others to commit the deed, promising them a good, big sum for their services. The men intended meeting Monday night and perfect arrangements, but fortunately their diabolical intentions were frustrated. Logan and McClury were arrested and jailed, being unable to give \$6,000 bonds. Rayburn has not been found. Everything is quiet now.
