The Incidental Fee for undergraduate students who are residents of Kentucky and enrolled for less than twelve hours of work during a regular semester is \$5.00 per semester hour. This fee for out-of-state students is \$10.00 per semester hour.

The Incidental Fee for graduate students who are residents of Kentucky and enrolled for less than twelve hours of work during a regular semester is \$6.00 per semester hour. This fee for out-of-state students is \$12.00 per semester hour.

All students enrolling for more than six hours during a semester are required to pay the regular laboratory and activity fees.
