Molniya I can send telephone, radio, still picture 'and teletype messages, in addition to television transmissions, according to reports. It's apparently similar to Telstar I, launated by the United States in July of 1962.

The latter decision is distarbing in view of the fact that FCC bylaws explicitly restrict the agency's jurisdiction to the airways, and give it no subterranean authority.
