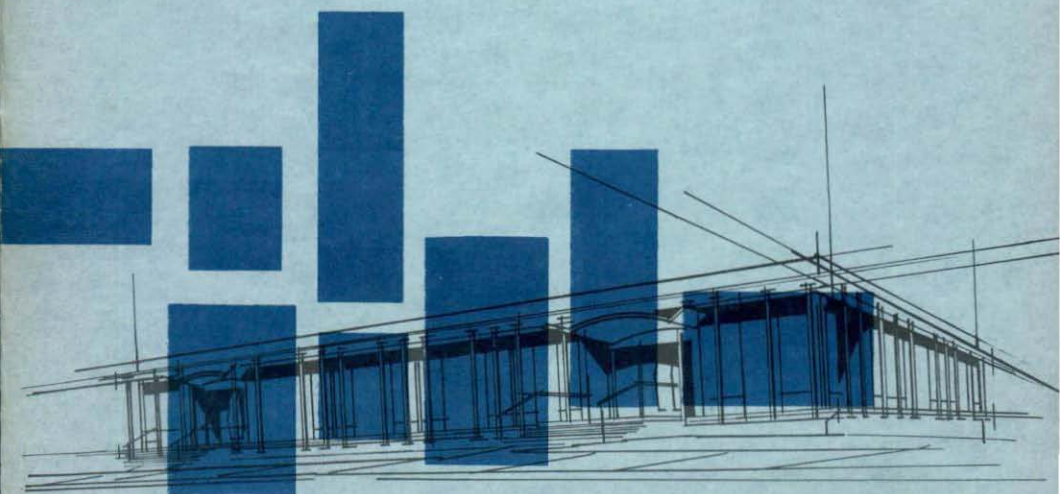

\*\*Total Raconteur fee - \$7.00, collected as follows: For students who enroll for both semesters of the school year - \$3.50 at the first semester registration and \$3.50 at the second semester registration. For students registering only for the second semester - \$7.00 for the second semester registration.

#### PART-TIME FEES

The incidental fee for undergraduate students who are residents of Kentucky and enrolled for less than twelve hours of work during a regular semester is \$7.50 per semester hour. This fee for out-of-state students is \$17.00 per semester hour.

The incidental fee for graduate students who are residents of Kentucky and enrolled for less than twelve hours of work during a regular semester is \$10.00 per semester hour. This fee for out-of-state students is \$23.00 per semester hour.

All students enrolling for more than six hours during a semester are required to pay the regular instructional supplies and activity fees.

#### FEES FOR GRADUATE INSTRUCTION

Residents of Kentucky - \$10.00 per semester hour. Maximum \$87.50  
Out-of-state students - first nine hours, \$23.00 per hour. Maximum \$200.00

#### OTHER EXPENSES

The college maintains a modern cafeteria and grill in the Doran Student House and food may be purchased at reasonable rates.

Books and necessary supplies may be secured at the College Bookstore. Prices on these items are held at a minimum.

Consult the Catalog for special fees for late registration, change of schedule, private instruction in music, and graduation.

#### REFUNDS

Refunds of fees will be made as follows:

A student withdrawing during the first week of school will be refunded 75 percent of his fees.

A student withdrawing within the first three weeks of school will be refunded 50 percent of his fees.

No refund of fees will be made after the first three weeks.
