To the Members of the Study Committee:

On Wednesday, January 31 at 7 P.M., Mr. Dembinsky of the Walcker Organ Company will meet with the Study Committee to answer questions about the proposed organ. Also I have asked Mr. Ken Miller of Chrisman-Miller Architects of Lexington to meet with us.

This will be the first time I have met with Mr. Miller but he is highly recommended and has done some work for the Methodist Church here and has designed the renovations for the Presbyterian Church here. He is a member of the South Hills Methodist Church and was the architect for that church. We have entered into no formal agreement with either of these men, but they are interested in our church building project and it will give us a chance to see if we could work with them.

I was particularly anxious to have an architect meet with an organ installation man to get their ideas, and of course we need your ideas and suggestions.

For those of you who have not previously received it, enclosed is a summary of the work Mrs. Severy has done for us in contacting organ companies. I believe you will find these quite helpful. Since she last talked to Mr. Dembinsky, he extended the "deadline" from January 31 to February 29 and added an additional rank of pipes (77 pipes) and the cost of a performance bond. It is obvious to me that he wants to do business with us and he apparently has a great deal to offer our church.

On Tuesday, February 6 from 7:30-9:30 Dr. Franklin E. Rector of the Board of Church Extension will be here to meet with us. He is what they call a "Study Consultant" for the Board and has been extremely helpful in assisting churches make wise building decisions. This is a free service of the Board of Church Extension.

Please mark these dates on your calendar and plan to be present. If you have any questions or comments, please let me know. Pray for divine guidance in these critical months before us. Your spiritual strength and wisdom are needed at this time.
