Congressional. March 4th, G. P. M. SAYRE - Motion of Mr. Atherton for the appointment of the General Post Office was taken up and considered.

Mr. Douglas of Illinois presented the credentials of Gen. Shields, and moved that in justice to all concerned, it be referred to the Judiciary Committee.

Mr. Bright of Indiana presented the credentials of Gov. Whitcomb. A bill for extending the revenue laws over Upper California establishing districts, rates of collection &c.

Horse - The substitute offered by Truman Smith of Conn., for the bill providing for the claims of American soldiers against Mexico, according to the treaty, was considered and finally passed.

Mr. Wentworth of Ill., moved to amend the Senate's amendment to the appropriation bill by attaching to it the following: Rejected, yeas 99, nays 96.

A motion was made to amend Mr. Walker's amendment for the provisional government of California by substituting the Ordinance of 1793. Rejected - yeas 81; nays 85.

Various amendments were now offered - but were not. The Committee of the whole rose and reported to the House with Walker's amendment. The vote of the House was now taken upon the bill as amended and lost - yeas 106; nays 114.

Mr. Ashman moved to suspend the rules in order to offer a resolution authorizing the best of Adams subscribed for by members to be placed in the speaker's room and paying the expenses, &c., of the artist. Mr. Jones of Tenn. objected.

Mr. Grinnell offered an amendment to strike out all relating to the expenses. - It was unavailing that the name of Adams should be called in vain.

Amendment accepted and resolution passed - yeas 136; nays 14.

Mr. Talmauld moved a suspension of the rules to take up the bill authorizing the establishment of a branch mint in N. York. The previous question was called for and sustained.
