PREFACE

The Research and Creative Productions (RCP) Committee does not attempt to assess the artistic or scholarly merit of the entries. The formatting of the entries follows discipline standards.

Only publications, professional meeting presentations, published abstracts, art exhibits, performances, compositions, and research and creative production grants awarded between January 1, 2019, and December 31, 2019, were included in this Annual Report. References to entries forthcoming to be published, performed, or exhibited in 2019 were excluded.

As a publication of the Research and Creative Productions Committee, this report highlights faculty/staff scholarship and recognizes individuals receiving RCP committee grants, summer fellowships, and Distinguished Awards. In addition to these internal awards, MSU faculty and staff received over \$11.7 million in grants and contracts from Federal, State, and other agencies in the past year to help support instruction, research, and service missions of the University.
