HOTECTEAD EXEMPTION IN MICHION, A bill has recently passed both houses of the classification of Michigan by large majorities exempting certain property from forced sales. The bill exempts forty acres with cases, and the little grant property from forced sales or legal process for any debt contracted after the 3d July, 1868, but excepting any mortgare jointly executed by hashand and wife. Similar laws have been passed in Georgia, Texas and Comnecticut.
