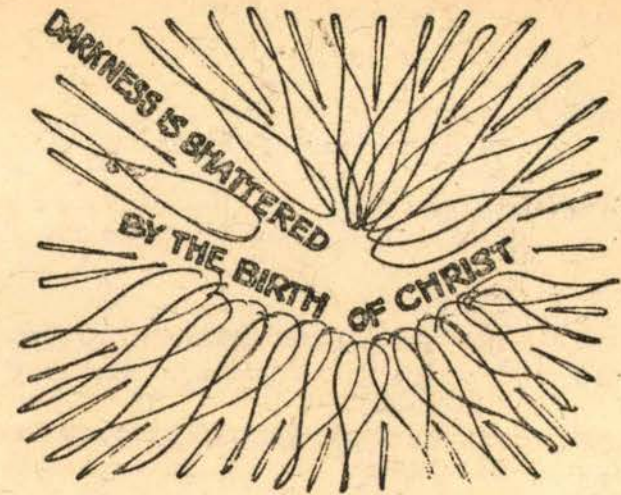

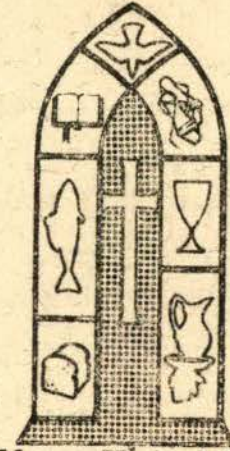
NEW HYMN BOOKS?

MY FAITH LOOKS UP TO THEE

-Ray Palmer 1808-1887

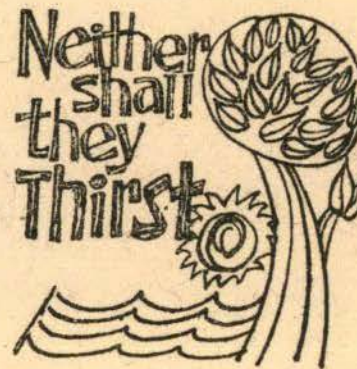
This hymn was written as a deeply personal and private exercise of Mr. Palmer's own Christian faith. One day he met Lowell Mason and was invited to submit several hymns and tunes for a new hymnal being planned. The two gentlemen stepped into a store and Mr. Palmer copied these words from his notebook and gave them to Mason. Several days later they met again and Mason predicted that Palmer would go down in history as a great hymn writer because of the context of this beautiful text.

Dr. Palmer wrote about 38 hymns including a number of free translations from the Latin. He is held in high esteem by hymnologists and churchmen alike for his thoughtfulness, poetic flow, and deep Christian devotion.

HAVE THINE OWN WAY, LORD!

Adelaide Pollard -1860-1934 - This hymn is believed to have been written while Miss Pollard was suffering deep depression of soul. She was from Iowa, was educated in various academies in Iowa, Indiana and Boston. She was always interested in mission work. She spent several months in Africa then was transferred to Scotland, and eventually returned to America.

The composer, George Coles Stebbins -1845-1945 was one of America's outstanding composers of hymn tunes. He lived to be 99 years old.

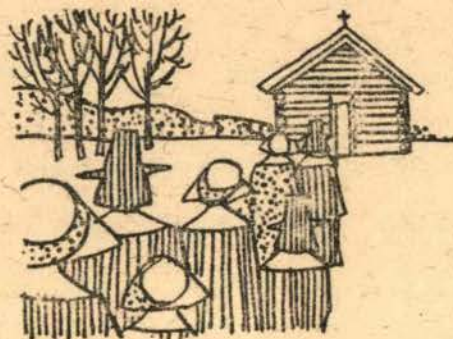
