BENEATH THE CROSS OF JESUS


This beautiful hymn was written by Elizabeth Cecilia Douglas Clephane (1830-69) in 1968. From her youth she was delicate healthwise, To the limit of her strength she served the poor and the sick in Melrose, Scotland. She and her sister gave to charity all they did not need for family maintenance, even to selling their horse and carriage. She was known to the townspeople as "the Sunbeam",

This hymn centers attention upon the culminating fact in the life of Christ-His willingness to carry on His mission to men even to the death. Ever since His death of the cross, the constant symbol of the sacrificial life, commemorating the historic event, and challenging men to match Jesus' heorism with a like heroism in His cause. Through the centuries thousands have risen to that challenge.

Stanza 1. The cross becomes for this Scottish saint the symbol of rest for her soul on its last journey. For her now the world is a wilderness, a scorching desert; a cross as a place of rest for the weary and the heavy-laden

The imagery comes from the Bible: "The mighty rock" Isaiah 32:2; "weary land," realm 63:1; "Home within the wilderness," Jeremiah 9:2; "rest upon the way," Isaiah 28:12; "noontide heat," Isaiah 4:6; "burden of the day," Matthew 11:30. The Scots knew their Bible

This lady also wrote "nock of Ages, cleft for me", "There were ninety and nine".


CHRISTMAS POINSETTIAS
