PURPOSE OF WEEK OF THE LAITY





nce there was a saintly rabbi named Rabbi Zalman. He lived on the second floor of a building, and his son, Rabbi Dov Ber, lived on the ground floor with his wife and baby. One day, Rabbi Dov Ber, who was known for his powers of great concentration, was so absorbed in the study of a holy text that he didn't hear the baby fall out of the cradle next to him.

On the floor above, the grandfather, Rabbi Zalman, heard the baby fall. He came downstairs, picked up the crying child, comforted him, and placed him back in the cradle. Later that day, he told Rabbi Dov Ber: "It is good to be so surrendered in holiness that you do not hear a bell ring, a knock at the door — but you must always hear the cry of a child. What is the point of communion with God, if you neglect godliness in this world?

"Never fail to bear the cry of a child."

The Children Are Crying

- Every minute, 15 children in the world die for want of essential food and inexpensive vaccines.
- Each year, 15 million children under the age of five die of hunger one-fourth of all the world's deaths.
- Five million children under the age of five die annually of dehydration caused by diarrhea.
- Vaccine-preventable diseases kill nearly 3.5 million children each year in the developing world.
- There are more than 18 million refugees in the world, more than 75 percent of whom are children.
- One million children are forced into the sex markets every year to serve the increasing demands of tourists and organized sex tours from industrialized nations.
- By the year 2000, 16 million children one in four of all American children will be poor.
- One of every four homeless persons in the United States is a child.
- There are more than 100 million street children around the world who live in fear every day of their lives.

Responding To The Cries

Through Week of Compassion and our partners such as Church World Service, Heifer Project International and the Cooperative Disaster Childhood Program, Disciples hear and respond to the cries of the world's children by providing:

- food, blankets, medicine and recreational equipment to more than 20,000 boys who have been orphaned and displaced by the civil war in Sudan;
- emergency day care to children in south Florida after Hurricane Andrew, in the Midwest after the '93 floods and in Los Angeles after the Northridge earthquake;
- counseling and rehabilitation for victims of the child prostitution industry in Southeast Asia;
- a home for handicapped children in Vietnam and flood ravaged children in Iowa;
- a school for poor children in New Caledonia and in the Philippines;
- school supplies to war-weary children in Bosnia and flood-weary children in Kansas;
- a health nurse for sick children in Jamaica and Somalia;
- day care for neglected children in Argentina and refugee children in Jordan;
- livestock training for the mothers of children in Peru and Kenya.





CHURCH BOARD WILL NOT MEET IN DECEMBER


