Historical Information: The first Student Council at Morehead State Normal School was organized in the fall of 1931. In the fall of 1971, the Student Council was renamed the Student Government Association. The organization's primary goal is to address student concerns, improve the overall quality of student life and to enhance the college experience at Morehead State.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of meeting minutes and supplementary materials created by the Student Government Association of Morehead State University from the fall of 1973 to spring of 1998. The collection contains membership lists, election records, campaign materials, agendas, resolutions, constitutions, newsletters, handbooks, budgets, financial statements, correspondence, memorandums and ephemera. Included in the collection are election results from the spring of 1998 to spring of 2000.
