





The Assembly Logo

(The logo for the 1996 Regional Assembly was designed by Mark and Lisa Caldwell-Reiss, Burgin, KY)

The logo is based on the Assembly theme and the study paper prepared by Rev.A. Guy Waldrop, General Minister of the Christian Church In Kentucky, entitled "The Visible Church". Each of the elements in the foreground are clay vessels which have served the church through the centuries as symbols of God's Spirit and glory revealed among us.

The Chalice stands for the gathering of God's people around the Lord's Table in congregational and denominational settings.

The **Bible**, "a lamp to our feet" (Psalm 119:105), and the lamp itself refers to the revelation of God's wisdom and guidance through scripture and study.

The **Pitcher** reminds us of the woman at the well, who saw revealed in Jesus, water of life (Luke 4:7-15).

These waters are also in the **Basin**. Even as our own thirst is quenched in the abundance of God's glory, this glory is visible to the world when it is poured out in service. We follow Jesus' example by serving lovingly and accepting service gracefully (John 13:1-11).

The **People** in the background, like the items in front, are clay vessels (II Cor. 4:7-12), eager and rejoicing to be filled and poured out and filled again that the Glory of God may ever be visible in the church.


RECONCILIATION Policies and Guidelines for Making Grants

- Grants are made to projects that aim to strike at the primary causes of racism in North America.
- Reconciliation intends to help projects begin and not be a long-term funding source.
- Reconciliation will normally not fund a project for more than three years.
- Reconciliation grants are normally in the \$1,000-\$5,000 range.
- Reconciliation normally does not fund a project's full budget.
- Grants are made to projects aimed at improving race relations through education and cross-cultural awareness.
- Consideration will normally not be given to requests for capital expenditures such as buildings, fixtures, equipment, or grounds; loans for business ventures, or to liquidate indebtedness.
- Reconciliation will not fund grants submitted by an agency with a member of the General Reconciliation Committee affiliated with the submitting agency.

Applications must be postmarked no later than June 1, each year, to be considered for funding.

RECONCILIATION MISSION


E liminating racism in North
America became the new focus
of Reconciliation in 1993. The next two
years (1994-1995) were spent introducing
the Church to this new focus.

1996 marks the beginning of the introduction of a new process specifically addressed to the goal of eliminating racism in North America. The process consists of: claiming a working definition of racism; naming the root causes of racism; and, coming before God in confession and repentance.

T he objective of this process is to help all races, all peoples, all of God's children... to recognize racism, repent of racism, and be reconciled.

"...the people of Israel were assembled with fasting and sackcloth, and with earth on their heads. Then those of Israelite descent... stood and confessed their sins and the iniquities of their ancestors."

NEHEMIAH 9:1-2



RACISM: A WORKING DEFINITION

R acism is the systemic/institutional myth that one race is inherently superior to all other races.

I n North America, racism is the systemic/institutional myth that whites are superior to all non-whites, and that all non-whites are inherently inferior. This myth is deeply inbedded in the psyche of all of us in North America: African Americans, American Asians, Anglos, and Hispanics.

T his myth, combined with the unbridled power to use structures, policies, and practices that exclude non-whites from the sources of real power, goods, education, jobs, and other services guaranteed to all humans, constitutes North American racism.

In other words, North American racism is a combination of racial bigotry and unbridled power. The power element of racism may be beyond the reach of all processes wishing to dilute or transfer power at this late date. But, bigotry is get-at-able!

T he Gospel of Jesus Christ has something to say about this sin: confess, repent, and be reconciled.

WHAT ARE THE ROOT CAUSES OF RACISM?

Common tap water consists of two elements: hydrogen and oxygen. Separating the two parts of hydrogen from the one part of oxygen eliminates water.

In the same fashion, racism can be eliminated by separating racial bigotry from power.

B igotry (i.e. a strong unfavorable attitude towards another person or group) is itself a multi-faceted, dynamic self-perpertuating social phenomenon in North America. It includes at least seven distinct facets:

BIGOTRY

- Separation
- Prejudice
- Stereotyping
- Devaluation
- Fear
- Scapegoating
- Overgeneralization

To eliminate racism, it is crucial to break down and overcome these facets of bigotry—to recognize them in ourselves and to repent of them.
