





WEEK OF COMPASSION UPDATE

Oklahomans and Kansans continue to dig out from some of the most ferocious tornadoes to strike the Great Plains this century. 51 people have been killed, more than 500 hundred injured, and thousands of homes, farms and businesses destroyed or damaged. In several communities major employers have been debilitated, jeopardizing the employment of hundreds of

The Disciples community in the region has been severely impacted as well. The sanctuary of First Christian in Haysville, KS was destroyed. More than 50 Disciples families in at least 17 congregations have lost homes. Among those who died in the tornadoes, one person was a member of Hillcrest CC, OKC.

Hillcrest CC, OKC.
Week of Compassion has provided \$31,000 to Disciples regional offices in Oklahoma and Kansas to assist with immediate needs in our congregations. WOC has committed an initial \$15,000 to Church World Service for interfaith relief efforts. WOC Director Johnny Wray is traveling in the region now to visit pastors and survivors and to coordinate additional Disciples' responses. Local Disciples are heavily involved in relief efforts. First Christian in Del City is serving as a relief center for the community. Disciples Linda Reed Brown and Larry Bishop are two of several CWS Disaster Response Consultants already at work. MISSION AND MINISTRY IN ARGENTINA

Timothy and Jodi Bobbitt are missionaries in Buenos Aires, where Tim is pastor of the Saavedra congregation and Jodi is involved in health ministries at the Community Center in La Tablada, which includes "Casa del Nino," a pre-school children's program.

Tim and Jodi have written about their efforts to reach out in their community where violence and drugs are increasing. In describing their emphasis on children and youth they wrote, "New leaders stepped up to take on the task of our church youth group. It grew from about 12 children a week to over 20 each week. Several of the children whose parents do not attend worship are also beginning to join us on Sunday mornings. The addition of Sunday School for both children and adults has been quite a hit. Other new activities include an evening basketball program and school tutoring, which have been very successful. We are looking forward to a large pastor's class with baptisms at Pentecost."

The "Casa del Nino" is the only free pre-school in their impoverished area. The program provides two meals a day, a shower and tutoring for 50 children age 5 to 15. Children are referred to the program by schools or other organizations because of learning disabilities or behavior problems. The children come from poor neighborhoods where families don't have the means to deal with these problems. The Bobbitts write, "They are a challenging group at times but are grateful for the opportunity to come to the center."

One of Jodi's most important duties is health education. Some of her programs have included dental health care, lice prevention and nutrition. When she last wrote she was planning some new workshop themes dealing with violence. positive self image and serving others.


A DEEP ABIDING SENSE OF COMMUNITY

Lydia and Jack Johnson-Hill are missionaries engaged in theological education in Fiji. Last November they wrote of graduation at Pacific Theological College.

At the beginning of the year each staff family is given responsibility for an 'advisory group,' a mixture of students and support staff and their families. The focus of the groups is personal with laughter, story-telling and music making as well as prayer together and the sharing of tough issues in their personal lives.

There is also a communal dimension as everyone helps students having a hard time. One such student had missed the official deadline for submitting the final draft of his thesis. "A student who was good at English would sit with him late into the night, helping him convert his Tongan grammar into English grammatical forms. Another student gently encouraged him to keep going. Two staff members became like parents, offering emotional as well as academic guidance. Lydia proof read the final draft. Through it all, we prayed, cajoled, sternly reprimanded and kept starting again. The other students said that they could not celebrate the completion of their own theses until everyone was finished. And finish he did. Everyone had passed and now everyone could celebrate."

And, there was the spiritual time when each departing student and staff member had opportunity at daily chapel to say what the experience at PTC had meant for their own Christian journey. "One student courageously shared the faith struggle he and his wife have endured as she has battled with cancer all year. She could barely muster the strength to stand, but she read the 23rd Psalm as it has never been read before. And we wept,"







The Rev. Karl and Jan Whiteman are missionaries serving in the Marshall Islands. Karl is Liaison Pastor for Micronesia and the Marshall Islands and theological education instructor; Jan is an Elementary and English educator.

The words of Deut. 32:2-3 are Jan's daily prayer as she teaches, and earning her students' trust and affection has made it possible for her to make a difference in their lives. Karl describes it this way.

"Teacher, teacher! What is love? What is 'opposite' sex? What is dating?"

In the Marshallese culture, young girls only learn about relationships and he physical and emotional changes that happen to all adolescents from their older sisters or aunts, friends and sometimes their grandmothers. Traditionally parents never talk to them about such things, and, for the most part, the liscussion of these subjects is usually avoided.

After a year of teaching 8th grade at Rita Christian School in Majuro, Aarshall Islands, five girls trusted Ian enough to seek her out at "the feast" ollowing a youth rally to ask what these words meant. A lively hour-long question and answer" session followed which may have changed the lives of iese young women living in a society of overnopulation, sexually transmitted iscases, and rampant teen pregnancy.

"Thank you, Teacher. We'll never forget you," the girls say.





Goats can thrive in extreme climates and on poor, dry land by eating grass, leaves, even twigs.



DUCKS AND GEESE GIVE RESULTS

Ducks and geese are among the most versatile and useful domestic animals.

They're easy to raise, don't require much shelter, and can adapt to hot, wet or cold weather. They can find some of their own food and efficiently dispose of weeds, slugs and snails while they fertilize the garden.



Quality geese lay obout 75 large eggs a year and ducks, up to 300. Heifer Project partners value ducks and geese because they're efficient egg and meat producers.

Families find ready markets for duck and goose products. And because families pass breeding eggs or young birds on to others in need, HPI ducks and geese can improve the quality of life for an entire community.

As of July 13 we have collected enough money to buy two flocks of chickens, two bee hives, two trios of rabbits, a pair of water buffalo, and a pair of donkeys.



BUILDING A FUTURE FOR THEMSELVES

Daniel and Sandra Gourdet serve in Bulawayo, Zimbabwe. Daniel is Development Officer involved with community and church projects-food production and distribution, cattle and poultry raising and income generating projects. Sandra works with the Women's Desk for the United Congregational Church of Southern Africa (UCCSA), Zimbabwe Synod, They often work together since most community development programs are organized by women, They write of the problems the country faces--salaries croding in value, AIDS. malaria, fear of cholera from Mozambique, domestic violence. The problems are overwhelming and beyond the ability of the church alone to change, but they write, "The UCCSA recognizes her responsibility of being involved in a holistic ministry. If the community suffers, the church suffers as well. We are grateful to be part of this church as it seeks to witness to the community."

Describing what development means to them, they write, "We don't see development as just projects. It is about building relationships and building people so that they can build a future for themselves. It is about building one's strength and viability, like a plant from the roots upward. It is a journey that never ends, but rather, it is like a spring from which water continuously flows."

"Garden projects at Invathi and Hope Fountain (the oldest missions in the entire country) provide a valuable source of income for the church as well as providing employment for several persons. 
The stranger looked down at this feet on the ground, Only he knew just why they were bare. A beggar that day without shoes passed his way, And the stranger had given his pair.

Disciples families profoundly affected by NC hurricane

Indianapolis (DNS) - - Thousands of North Carolina families have been dislocated from their homes, farms have been ruined, businesses destroyed, and water, sanitation, highway and other infrastructure systems damaged following Hurricane Floyd last week. The large Disciples community in eastern North Carolina has been profoundly affected by the storm system.

"This part of the tar heel state is facing a major humanitarian, economic and ecological disaster," said the Rev. Johnny Wray, director of Week of Compassion for the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ).

The homes of hundreds of Disciples families are underwater, many of them without flood insurance. St. Luke's Christian Church in Princeville is submerged. 



Following Jesus


I follow my savior one step at a time
