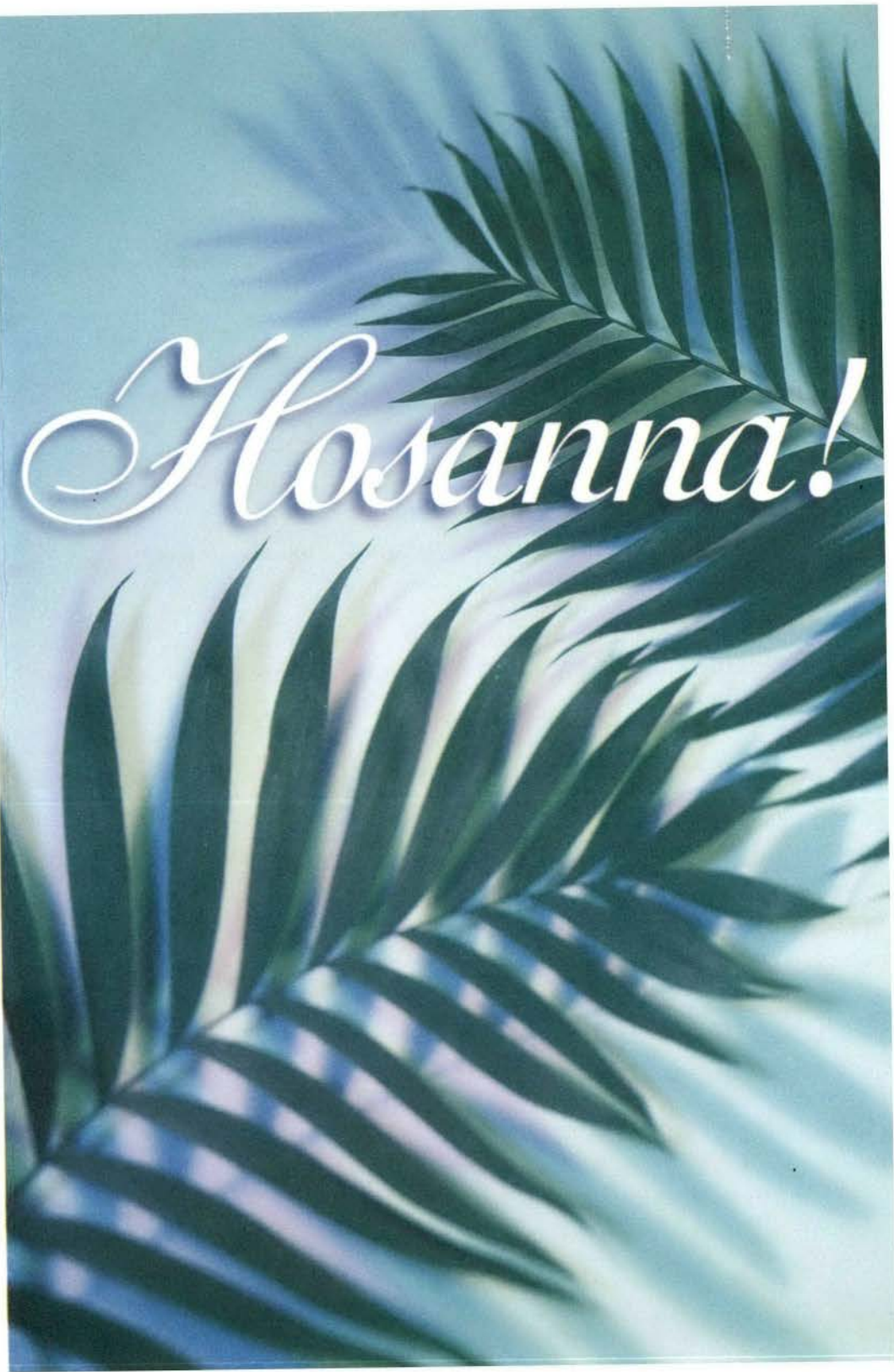

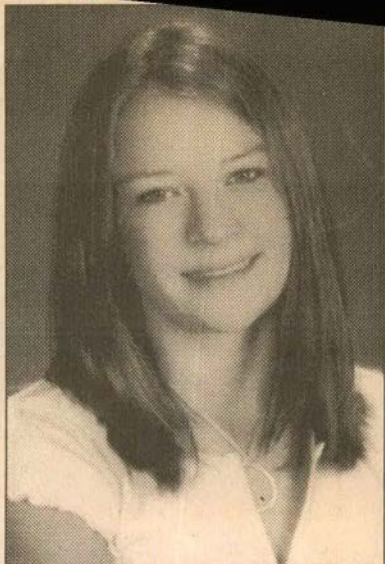

Prisons From A-4

Rather than summarize the speech for you, I'd like to just have you read a portion of it. There is not much more I can add:

The subject of prisons and corrections may tempt some of you to tune out. You may think, "Well, I am not a criminal lawyer. The prison system is not my problem. I might tune in again when he gets to a different subject." In my submission you have the duty to stay tuned in. The subject is the concern and responsibility of every member of our profession and of every citizen. This is your justice system; these are your prisons. The Gospels' promise of mitigation at judg-

zens can say, "I was in prison and ye came unto me," does contain an exemption for practitioners, or transaction lawyers, or for any other zen. And, as I will suggest, energies and diverse talents the entire Bar are needed to address this matter.

Even those of us who have specific professional responsibilities for the criminal justice system can be neglectful when it comes to the subject of corrections. The focus of the legal profession, perhaps even an obsessive focus, has been the process for determining guilt or innocence. When someone has been judged guilty at the appellate and collateral
