Historical Information: The General Education Council at Morehead State University was established in the fall of 2007 to compose a new General Education program and evaluate and assess courses to be included in the program. The Council was also assigned the responsibility of defining student transfers, professional development of faculty, performing curriculum audits, and examining outcomes to improve the program.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of meeting minutes, program reviews, assessment reports, retention plans and other materials created or retained by the General Education Council of Morehead State University from 1999 to 2017. The collection contains files on academic advising, medical and nursing programs, curriculum approval policies, and reports from the Statewide Transfer Committee. Included with the files are computer compact discs with digitally born records associated with the General Education Council.
