Youthful, inexperienced and hard working may be the best way to describe the 1976 edition of Morehead State University's cross country team.

Coach Buck Dawson returns four lettermen and welcomes seven newcomers to the squad, which finished fourth in the Ohio Valley Conference last season.

Returning will be Georgetown, Ohio, senior Dan Lindsey, who will captain the Eagle harriers. Juniors Mark Baughey and Gary Warren also return, along with sophomore Rod Cook.

Heading the list of newcomers is freshman David Bowman. Bowman, from Alum Creek, W. Va., is considered an outstanding prospect.

"He'll have to make the big transition from high school to college cross country," Dawson said, "but I know he has the potential."

Other newcomers include Jo Jo Dean, Marty Withrow, Steve Adkisson, Mike Thomas, and Barry Dennis. Juco transfer Rick Ferguson may provide some aid, along with sprinter Kelvin Kelley, who Dawson hopes will make the Eagles more competitive.

"This is the hardest working bunch I've had," Dawson said, "and that sometimes overrides a little inexperience."

Morehead State University Women's Tennis Coach Sue Lucke has scored a couple of aces in this year's recruiting, landing what she feels are the two best prospects ever signed by Morehead State's women's tennis program.

Coach Lucke feels that freshmen signees Paula Jones and Sally Hockwalt will help the MSU team rebound from last year's 2-4 record.

Jones is a native of Kingstown, Jamaica, but came to Morehead State via London, England, where she was captain and No. 1 player on her high school tennis team.

Hockwalt, from Dayton, Ohio, has taken over the No. 1 spot on the roster because of her previous tournament experience. Coach Lucke said Hockwalt spent most of the summer competing in various invitationals in the Dayton area.

Leading the corps of veterans returning are juniors Dale Rankin from Ashland, Ky., and Morehead native Hedy Clark Kuhn. Also coming back are sophomores Kelli Muterspaw from Xenia, Ohio, and Cindy Queen of Morehead. Rankin and Muterspaw teamed up for MSU's most successful doubles team last season.

Coach Lucke feels the Eagles' strongest asset lies in the doubles combinations of Rankin-Muterspaw and the possible new one, Jones-Hockwalt.

"I'm very enthusiastic about the schedule, the improvement of last year's players, and the talent our new people are demonstrating," said Coach Laradean Brown.

MSU returns seven players from last season's 22-5 squad, and with the addition of five freshmen, Coach Brown hopes to use more specialization this season.

The volleyball Eagles face a stronger schedule this season with the addition of Tennessee and several strong Ohio schools.

"With the schedule we have, we'll quickly find where our strengths and weaknesses lie," the coach concluded.
