**Historical Information:** The library at Morehead State University dates back to the days when the college was Morehead Normal School. The first recorded library was that of the school's principal in 1902, which had close to 1,000 books and was noted as being accessible to students. The library was first located at Burgess Hall. The library was relocated to the new Administrative Building (Rader Hall) in 1926. A new library building was constructed in 1929 and named Johnson Camden Library the following year. Two additions to the building were added, one in 1965 and the other in 1978. After the second addition the building was renamed Camden-Carroll Library in honor of Governor Julien Carroll.

**Scope and Content:** Collection consists of reprinted promotional materials originally published by the Morehead State Normal School (predecessor of Morehead State University) from 1925 to 1929.
