

Want Troops in Rowan County, Kentucky.

LOUISVILLE, Ky., Aug. 1.—The county judge of Rowan county has made a second demand for troops to protect the county and the governor has decided to send two companies of state guards and a Gatling gun to Morehead. Many people left Morehead Friday night for fear of being killed in an expected attack by the Tolliver faction, which band is supposed to number about 100. The telegraph operator was shot and has left, but a new man has taken his place. The town is still guarded by forty men, but dissensions have sprung up among the anti-Tolliver faction and they are not to be relied upon to protect the place.
