Morehead, Ky., Feb. 7.—Scoring almost at will, the Morehead Eagles breezed to a 50-21 victory over New River State of West Virginia here tonight.

The score easily could have been much higher had Coach Ellis Johnson elected to use his first-stringers throughout. But after taking a 15-4 lead in the early minutes, Johnson substituted an entire second team. At that, the Eagles held a 20-8 edge at intermission.

The first-stringers returned at the start of the third period and stretched the margin to 45-18 before again giving way to the subs.

Tallent, Eagle center, was outstanding for his team with nine points. Captain Hammer paced the visitors with eight points.

In the preliminary, the Morehead frosh whipped an independent team from Ashland, 37-24.
