

CARDS BEHIND 23-22 AT HALF INK. L. A. C. TILT

Morehead, Ky., Feb. 15.—The Eagles of Morehead State Teachers College screamed over the Cardinals of the University of Louisville by 40-35 here tonight in a stirring K. L. A. C. edge struggle. The favored Cardinals could not cope with best offensive game the Eagles have displayed all season.

Louisville outscored its host by fourteen baskets to twelve from the field, but lost out from the free throw line as it succeeded in making good on only seven of fifteen free throws to Morehead's sixteen of twenty-five.

Morehead, appearing on its home floor for the last time this season, held a slim 23-22 edge at the close of the initial half.

P. Doll opened the scoring on the first play of the game on a crisp shot. Rosson, who captured high scoring honors with thirteen points, sank a beauty from the side, and Tartar crippled to put the home forces out in front by 4-2. Monen's snow bird was matched with two fouls by Leslie. Ryan slipped under the basket to give the Eagles an 8-4 advantage before Long dropped in a foul and Leslie crippled. Monen tossed in a looper from well out on the court and Tartar sank two gratis flings before P. Doll and Keeling tallied 2-pointers to knot the count at

11-11 with ten minutes left in the first half.

Rosson and Masterson, who paced the Cardinals' attack with eleven markers, squared off from the free throw line after Rosson disturbed the netting from the side and Carter dropped in a foul. Masterson tipped in a follow up, his first basket of the game, to cut Morehead's margin to 15 to 14. Leslie sank one from the side, Tartar crippled and Leslie tossed in a free before Keeling crippled to make the scoreboard read 20 to 18 in favor of the Eagles.

Masterson's free-wheeler and P. Doll's snowbird tied the score again at 20 to 20. P. Doll put the Cardinal and Black ahead for the second time with a medium with two minutes to go. With a second left in the half, Tartar tied things up with a one-hander and then put the hosts ahead once more with a successful foul shot as the half closed.

Ryan and Monen matched long shots, Rosson sank a foul and Tartar a 2-pointer and a gratis toss to give the Eagles a 29-24 lead. Monen made good on a charity fling but Leslie and Carter sank two free throws each and Ryan slipped in for a crisp to make the count 35-25. Leslie's two one-pointers lengthened Morehead's advantage before Masterson counted on a fielder and two fouls. Rosson made a follow up and then fouled out, Panther making good on the gift. K. Doll dropped in a long, Johnson a foul and Masterson picked up two points from the side. Francis' foul ended the scoring.
