tribution from the State Legislature, which in the period from 1938-40 was \$35,000. Last year \$186,000 was spent by the Governor's Commission for Kentucky Crippled Children, and only \$3,000 of this amount was derived from the national Infantile Paralysis Drive. The importance of the annual membership drive lies in the fact that the greater the number of members, the greater will be the amount which the commission will be able to secure from the State Legislature.

The members of the Kentucky Crippled Children's Commission are selected by the governor and serve without pay, as do all workers in the Society. The membership of the Commission is as follows: Ben Williamson, Ashland; Mrs. E. C. Moore, Liberty; S. Lyman Barber, Louisville; Mrs. Paul Wickliffe, Greenville; Mrs. J. D. Augustus, Jr., Louisville; J. Sherman Porter, LaGrange; Thomas R. Underwood, Lexington; Marion Williamson, Louisville and Anna B. Quinn, Louisville.

The state-wide drive will start April 2nd, with the mailing of the following letter to every resident of Rowan County. The '40 state goal has been set at 50,000 members.

Dear Friend: You probably know about the splendid work that has been done in Rowan County by the Crippled Children's Commission and Society. Last year fifty-four cases were treated, fifteen cases discharged as corrected and thirty-nine of these cases are now active supervision. The Commission estimates the per capita cost of treating a crippled child in \$272.00. At this figure the Commission would have spent \$14,728.00 in treating the above number of cases. This includes only the hospital and medical care and does not include special services furnished by volunteer groups.

The splendid work that is being done in our county is made possible by your help, my help and the help of thousands of Kentuckians who are willing to do their part.

In a day or two a member of the Rowan County Committee will call on you and ask you to become a member of the Kentucky Society for Crippled Children. Your membership in the Society makes it possible for thousands of Kentucky's crippled children to have twisted bodies straightened and crippled legs and arms made well. Kentucky's crippled children are counting on you.
