

# STATE NORMAL SITES VOTED ON

The records of the voting done by the commission to select a site for the new Eastern Kentucky State Normal School will interest our readers we are sure. Here it is for both the Lexington and Frankfort meetings:

First ballot—Louisa: Barret and Peter; West Liberty—Combs, Senff and O'Rear; Morehead—Goodpaster; Paintsville—Harman and Wallen.

Second ballot—Paintsville: Garret, Harman, Peter and Wallen; West Liberty—Combs, Senff and O'Rear; Morehead—Goodpaster.

Third ballot—Louisa: Barret; West Liberty—Combs, Peter and O'Rear; Morehead—Goodpaster and Senff; Paintsville—Harman and Wallen.

The Lexington meeting ended here and September 1 the balloting for the Eastern Kentucky site was resumed at the Frankfort meeting. Ten ballots were taken as follows:

First—Paintsville: Harman and Wallen; Louisa—Barret and Peter; Morehead—Combs and Goodpaster; West Liberty—Senff and O'Rear.

Second Ballot—Paintsville: Barret, Harman, Peter and Wallen; Morehead: Combs, Goodpaster and Senff; West Liberty: O'Rear. Louisa dropped out on this ballot.

Third Ballot—Paintsville: Barret, Harman, Wallen; Louisa: Peter; Morehead: Combs and Goodpaster; West Liberty: Senff and O'Rear.

Fourth Ballot—Paintsville: Harman and Wallen; Morehead: Combs and Goodpaster; Louisa: Barret and Peter; West Liberty: Senff and O'Rear.

Fifth Ballot—Paintsville: Barret, Harman and Wallen; Morehead: Combs and Goodpaster; Louisa: Peter; West Liberty: Senff and O'Rear.

## Elimination Plan Carries.

At this point Commissioner Harman made a motion that any town receiving only one vote be dropped. This was carried and the sixth ballot followed:

Paintsville: Barret, Harman, Peter and Wallen; Morehead: Combs, Goodpaster and Senff; West Liberty: O'Rear.

Seventh Ballot—(West Liberty was dropped.) Paintsville: Barret, Harman, Peter and Wallen; Morehead: Combs, Goodpaster, Senff and O'Rear.

The result of the next 13 ballots was the same as that of the seventh.

After the twentieth ballot a motion was made that a committee be appointed to "receive delegations from Paintsville, Louisa and Morehead for the purpose of ascertaining the exact steps each town has taken to qualify under the law." Chairman O'Rear named Commissioners Goodpaster and Combs on this committee.
