

NORMAL CASES TO BE HEARD JAN. 10

Judge Hurst To Act As Special Judge

All three of the civil suits attacking the legality of the act creating the two new normal schools recently awarded to Murray and Morehead, respectively, were set for trial on January 10 before Judge Sam Hurst of Breathitt county today, it was learned here.

The information came from Superintendent of Public Instruction George Colvin to Robert T. Caldwell, attorney for the plaintiffs in the Eastern Kentucky suit.

The suits will be heard in the Franklin circuit court at Frankfort with Judge Hurst acting as special judge in the absence of Judge Robert Stout, who is ill.

Both sides in the cases have announced they will appeal the decision in case of adverse judgment.
