

PROF. HAGGAN GOES WITH STATE NORMAL AT BRODHEAD

Prof. H. C. Haggan has resigned his position as principal of the Perryville High School and will leave September 24 to accept the position of head of the Science Department at the Brodhead Normal School, one of the new normal schools established this year by the State of Kentucky. Prof. Haggan has been with the Perryville High School for four years and was just beginning his fifth term. Under his leadership the school has made rapid strides, the enrollment increasing from 145 to 265. A large number of the boys and girls finishing the Perryville High School have gone to colleges and the school has in every way been a great success. Prof. Haggan was also connected with the Smith-Hughes Vocational Agriculture Department and did a great work in teaching agriculture. The new position at Morehead is somewhat of a promotion for Prof. Haggan, and while his many friends regret to see him leave Boyle county, they congratulate him and wish him unbounded success. His successor at Perryville has not been named.
