

72 FINISH AT MOREHEAD

Dr. M. B. Adams Delivers Address to Graduates

MOREHEAD, Ky., June 7.—The first commencement of the new Morehead State Normal school was held last night in Burgess hall, with Dr. M. B. Adams, president of Georgetown College, delivered the address.

Dr. T. U. Fann gave the invocation and President F. C. Button introduced the chief speaker. "The Need for Double Honor Men and Women in American Education," was the subject of Doctor Adams' address.
