

# *Dr. Robert Hutchins Will Speak at Inauguration of J. H. Payne at Morehead*

MOREHEAD, Ky., March 1.—Dr.

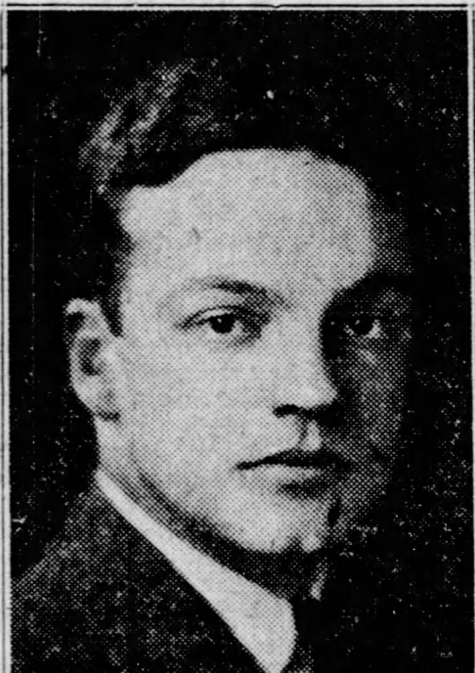
Robert Maynard Hutchins, the recently installed president of the University of Chicago, will be the principal speaker at the services here on May 2 when John Howard Payne, president of Morehead State Normal School and Teachers College, will be formally installed as president of the college. President Payne assumed his duties as president of the college here September 1, 1929.

More than 50 colleges and universities will be officially represented at the inaugural services, which will be held in the new auditorium at 10 o'clock in the morning.

Other features of the program will be the opening prayer by Dr. William J. Hutchins, of Berea, father of young Dr. Hutchins; the formal introduction of the official delegates by Dean William H. Vaughan, and the inaugural address by President Payne.

Dr. Hutchins is the son of Dr. William H. Hutchins, president of Berea College. He is the youngest university president in the United States. He received his first college degree from Yale less than 10 years ago and his law degree four years later. Dr. Hutchins' college work was somewhat delayed by his 14 months service in the American
