

THE SPECIAL TERM.

Hon. Asher Caruth Secures His First Conviction in the Rowan Circuit Court.

MOREHEAD, KY., July 27.--Hon. Asher Caruth secured his first conviction in the Rowan Circuit Court this morning, Charles Cobourn being sentenced to two years in the penitentiary for feloniously breaking into a freight car. Deputy Sheriff Ramsey, who has been under arrest for killing William Logan, was discharged to-day, the grand jury failing to return an indictment. During the investigation of the killing by the grand jury, Hiram Brain, a juror, came into court and informed Judge Cole that the investigation was such a one-sided affair he refused to serve further. Brain sympathizes with the Martin faction.

The following additional indictments were returned to-day: Against Cook Humphrey, for shooting at Sheriff Ramsey with intent to kill; Andy Eden, assault and battery; Howard Logan, malicious shooting.

Logan and Humphrey furnished bail. Mr. Caruth is working like a beaver, and his watchword is, "Let no guilty man escape."

The case against Gooden for murdering 'Squire Pelfrey was called, but postponed to the third day of the August term. Gooden was remanded to jail without bail.
