

## The Court's Work at Morehead.

MOREHEAD, Aug. 4.—To-day William Cornett, for confederating in a murder, got one year in the penitentiary; James Alfrey, for carrying concealed weapons, \$40 and ten days' hard labor. William Foutch, for cutting with intent to kill, had his bond forfeited. James Rayburn, charged with murder, fled away. Wm. Johnson, charged with murder, fled away. Obian Logan and Ed. Pearce, for conspirating with intent to kill, fled away. Cook Humphrey and Craig Toliver, charged with shooting, continued until the 9th. The number of cases called to-day were: Concealed weapons, 59; murder, 5; confederating and banding to kill, 5; shooting, 8; robbing, 3; arson, 1; cutting to kill, 1; poisoning, 1; perjury, 1; grand larceny, 1; assault, 3; detaining women, 2; gaming, 2; breach of peace, 1; total, 100. The total population of the entire county is 6,000.
