
Morehead State Honors Basketball All-Americans With Jersey Retirements





When Frank C. Button and his mother, Phebe, arrived by train in the small town of Morehead, Kentucky, in 1887, gunfire still rang in the streets. A long-running feud between the Martins and Tollivers had left the town in ruins. Its only hope of salvation, some folks said, was to establish a school -- a light to the mountains -- to restore serenity.

In his account of Morehead State's history, Dr. Donald F. Flatt brings to life the stories of the people and events which have shaped this institution of higher learning. The 300 pages of text are complemented by more than 100 photographs and document the academic, political, and athletic progress of the university of the mountains.

Dr. Ronald G. Eaglin

President



Dr. Ronald G. Eaglin became the 12th president of Morehead (Ky.) State University on July 1, 1992. Bringing nearly 30 years of experience in higher education administration to the MSU post, he previously was chancellor of Coastal Carolina University in Conway, S.C.

A former vice chancellor for academic affairs at the University of South Carolina's Spartanburg

campus, Dr. Eaglin began his career in higher education administration in the area of student life/housing and has taught both in public school and university settings. In the early 1970s, he served as southeast regional director of the American College Testing Program (ACT).

He holds a bachelor's degree in biology and mathematics from Southeast Missouri State University, a master's degree in student personnel administration from Southern Illinois University and a doctoral degree in educational psychology from the University of Utah.

A graduate of Leadership South Carolina, he is a member of the NCAA President's Commission. Active in the

American Association of State Colleges and Universities, President Eaglin is a member of its Board of Directors and has served on many AASCU committees.

He frequently serves as a consultant and often presents workshops for colleges on student retention, leadership and academic advisement. His professional efforts have taken Dr. Eaglin to Cyprus as chair of a Fulbright High Commission delegation and more recently to Taiwan, the Republic of China.

A member of several honorary societies such as Psi Chi and Phi Delta Kappa, Dr. Eaglin also is active in his community. As president of MSU, Dr. Eaglin serves as a member of the Board of Directors of the Morehead-Rowan Chamber of Commerce. A member of the Kentucky Council on Higher Education's Conference of Presidents, he was appointed by then Gov. Brereton C. Jones to the East Kentucky Development Roundtable, an advisory working group to the East Kentucky Office of the Cabinet for Economic Development. He also is a member of the steering committee of the Central Appalachian Alliance, a partnership of energy and land holding companies with universities in Kentucky and Virginia. Additionally, Dr. Eaglin is a member of the Kentucky Appalachian Commission and the Task Force to Develop a Master Plan on tourism for Kentucky.

Mike Mincey

Vice President for Student Life and Director of Athletics



Mike Mincey, Morehead State's Vice President for Student Life and a former Eagle athlete, added the title of Director of Athletics in February.

An MSU administrative staff member since 1975, Mincey was appointed interim vice president in 1986 and assumed the title of vice president and Dean of Students in 1990 following a national search. He assumed responsibility for su-

pervision of the University's athletics program in June, 1993. Since joining the staff, Mincey has held a variety of posts including assistant to the vice president for academic affairs, grants coordinator and coordinator for academic support services.

In addition to the athletics program, Mincey also provides supervisory support to the areas of the Dean of Students, student activities, student development, financial aid and scholarships, student housing and public safety.

A three-time graduate of the University, he earned a bachelor's degree and two master's degrees, one in higher education. The native of Waycross, Ga., has done advanced studies at Indiana University and is a member of the National Association of Student Personnel Administrators.

Prior to joining the MSU staff, he taught and coached in public schools in Flemingsburg, Ky., and Tifton, Ga.


Mincey earned four varsity letters (1965-68) as a member of the Eagle football squad. He was an all-stater at Ware County (Ga.) High School, and he was a member of MSU's last Ohio Valley Conference football championship squad in 1967.

His wife, the former Kathy Crusie of Lyndon, Ohio, is a two-time graduate of MSU and currently serves the University as an assistant professor of English. They have three children, Sarah, Jacob and Samuel.







Kyle Macy



Kyle Macy, one of the Commonwealth of Kentucky's best known and most popular basketball figures, begins his second season as the Head Men's Basketball Coach at Morehead State University.

In announcing Macy's appointment, MSU President Ronald G. Eaglin said: "We believe strongly that this outstanding young man is the right choice at the right time

to restore the proud basketball tradition at our institution and to lead the Eagles back to the forefront of the Ohio Valley Conference. Kyle has a wealth of basketball playing experience and a broad knowledge of the game. We are confident that he will be successful as a Division I coach."

Macy, born in Kendalville, Ind., and a high school standout at Peru (Ind.) High School, was a two-time All-American at the University of Kentucky and played on the Wildcats' 1978 national championship team. He played three seasons at Kentucky after spending one season at Purdue.

Following his collegiate career, he spent seven seasons in the NBA, playing for the Phoenix Suns, Chicago Bulls and Indiana Pacers. In all seven of his NBA seasons, his team qualified for the playoffs. He also played three seasons in the Italian professional league.

From 1993 through 1997, he served as the color analyst for the University of Kentucky Radio Network's broadcasts of Wildcat basketball. He has also worked with Host Creative TV, Host Communications Radio, Raycom Television Sports, SportsChannel, Mutual Radio, ESPN, WVLK-Radio and Westwood One Radio.

From August, 1994, until his appointment as Eagle coach, he was a Correspondent Banking Officer for Central Bank & Trust Company in Lexington.

Macy's annual basketball camp has been held for 18 years and approximately 1,000 youngsters and 125 coaches participate annually. He has also produced an instructional basketball video and published a high school basketball preview

"I'm extremely excited to be the head basketball coach at Morehead State," Macy said. "Becoming a head coach on the Division I level was something I'd been looking forward to since I was four-years old and sitting on the bench beside my father.

"As our program develops, our team will play an exciting, up-tempo style that players like to be involved in and fans like to watch. In order to progress, we will need to continue to recruit. And, we will need fan support. We hope that every home game will be an event that people look forward to. I'm confident that we can accomplish this turnaround as we implement our system and ideas and with the help of the MSU family of students, alumni, faculty and staff and friends."

The 41-year old Macy and his wife, Tina, have two daughters, Mallory Beth and Meredith Anne, and a son, Malone.

record of 123-41. He led the Tomcats to the runner-up spot in the 1996 Kentucky State High School Tournament.

He has one daughter, Khayla, age eight.



Earl Duncan, 1939-43

Morehead State's first basketball All-American in 1943. His 1,430 career points place him 11th on MSU's all-time scoring list. Had a 19.3 ppg. career scoring average. Three-time All-KIAC. Scored 35 points against Marshall in 1942-43. Led all college scorers in Kentucky in both 1941-42 and 1942-43. Came to the University from Georgetown, Ky.



Morehead State's second basketball All-American in 1945. Scored 1,011 points in his career and ranks 23rd on MSU's all-time scoring list. The "Brooksville Flash" came to MSU from Brooksville, Ky., after leading his high school team to the state championship in 1939. Eagle teams were 40-19 during his career.





John E. (Sonny) Allen, 1946-50

All-American in 1950. His 1,923 career points rank him third on MSU's all-time scoring list. Four-time All-Ohio Valley Conference. A native of Morehead, he coached the Baseball Eagles for 14 seasons and recorded a 226-137 record. He was OVC Coach of the Year three times. The Universitý's baseball field is named in his honor. When he retired in 1985, he was serving as MSU's assistant athletic director.

Dan Swartz, 1953-56

Morehead State's only two-time basketball All-American, having been honored in both 1955 and 1956. Scored 1,925 career points in only three seasons and ranks second on MSU's all-time scoring list. His 28.6 ppg. season scoring average in 1955-56 and his 27.5 ppg. career scoring average are school records. Selected All-Ohio Valley Conference twice. Scored 40 points or more in three different games. Came to the University from Owingsville, Ky.





Steve Hamilton, 1954-58

All-American in 1957. His 1,829 career points rank fourth on MSU's all-time scoring list, and he is the University's all-time leading rebounder with 1,675 rebounds. One of only two individuals to ever play in both an NBA Championship Series and a World Series. Coached the Baseball Eagles for 14 seasons and is the MSU's all-time winningest baseball coach with 305 victories. OVC Coach of the Year four times. Was serving as MSU's athletic director at the time of his death. Came to the University from Charleston, Ind

Harold Sergent, 1962-65

All-American in 1963. His 1,469 career points place him eighth on MSU's all-time scoring list. Earned All-Ohio Valley Conference honors three times and was league Player of the Year in 1962-63. Led MSU in scoring three times. Scored 52 points against Middle Tennessee in 1964-65. Also and All-OVC pitcher for the Baseball Eagles and still holds the school record for wins in a season with 10. Came to the University from Ashland, Ky.





Leonard Coulter, 1971-74

All-American in 1972. His 1,781 career points place him sixth on MSU's all-time scoring list. Ranks third on MSU's all-time rebounding list and 19th on the all-time assist list. Selected All-Ohio Valley Conference three times. Led MSU in scoring and rebounding all three years of his varsity competition. During his career, MSU was 38-14 against OVC competition. Scored a career-high 42 points against Tennessee Tech. Came to the University from Danville, Ky.

Donna Murphy, 1976-80

One of the finest woman basketball players in Kentucky history. MSU's all-time leading scorer with 2,059 points and all-time leading rebounder with 1,442 rebounds. Four-time All-KWIC and All-Ohio Valley Conference all three years she played in the league. OVC Player of the Year twice and league Woman Athlete of the Year in 1979-80. Two-time Kodak Regional All-American and Women's Basketball League All-American in 1978-79. Came to MSU after earning Miss Basketball honors at Newport High School. Murphy's jersey banner will be unfurled during Thursday's game against Middle Tennessee.

Laura Litter Head Coach



Entering her second year at the helm of the Morehead State program, Laura Litter looks to build upon her previous successes during stints as the head coach at Sullivan College and Lees College. In her 17-year career. Litter has been one of the most successful coaches in the game and having laid the foundation last year in her first season with the Blue and Gold, she looks to build a championship team at MSU

like she had done at her previous stops.

After a difficult first season at her alma mater, Coach Litter's 1998-99 Lady Eagles are poised to make strides within the conference. The two-time graduate of Morehead State University, was hired on April 1, 1997, and proceeded to lead her team to a 7-19 record in her first campaign, the only non-winning season in her career.

With a career record of 443-104, Litter's teams have posted 20-game winning seasons 16 out of 17 times. Her teams have won 30 or more games six years and have competed in the national tournament four times, including finishing third in the nation in 1993-94. She entered Morehead State with a career winning percentage of 84 percent.

Her most recent stop prior to MSU was as the eightyear mentor at Sullivan College in Lexington, Ky. There, she began the program and proceeded to notch a 30-2 record in the team's first season of play. By the time she left, she had compiled a 233-30 overall record at the school, won conference titles in each year and advanced to the National Junior College Athletic Association Region VII Tournament all eight times.

At Sullivan, Litter coached two NJCAA first-team and three second-team All-Americans, as well as three Kodak first-team All-Americans. In addition, her high-powered offense, generated a NJCAA scoring record in 1993-94, averaging 107.6 points per game, and were ranked as high as third nationally.

The Executives were a staple of the NJCAA Region VII Tournament from 1990 through 1997. Sullivan had its greatest success under Litter in her fouth year in Lexington. That season, the program advanced all the way to the Final Four, before losing by eight points to eventual national champion Trinity Valley (TX) to finish third.

But, her teams did more than just get it done on the court. Each one of her players that completed two years at the school either received their Associate's Degree or transferred to a four-year institution. Included among the future stops of her student-athletes were such notable basketball powers as Western Kentucky, Maryland, Auburn, Kentucky, Louisville and Drake. In total, 34 went on to play in college and 22 earned a spot on an NCAA Division I roster.

Her first head coaching venture was no different. Litter spent eight years pacing the sidelines of Lees College in Jackson, Ky., where she was responsible for taking over the reigns of a new program. The Lady Generals were in existence two years prior to her arrival. She subsequently tacked up a 203-55 record in eight years at the school.

At Lees, her squad won six conference titles and competed in the NJCAA Tournament eight times. She sent 25 athletes onward to play at Division I schools after they completed their careers at Lees. Of the 39 who lasted two years on the team, 35 either graduated or went on to finish their degree at another school.

Combined between her stops at the two schools, Litter earned 11 Kentucky Junior College Athletic Conference Coach of the Year honors and four NJCAA Region VII Coach of the Year awards in her 16-year reign. In addition, she was recognized by Lees College, which placed her in its Hall of Fame in 1995.

The native of Chillicothe, Ohio, played the 1976-77 year at Morehead State, before succumbing to a careerending injury. She remained as a graduate assistant coach at her alma mater under Mickey Wells, serving in that capacity through the 1980-81 campaign.

She earned her bachelor's degree in recreation and business administration in 1980 and then her master's degree from MSU in education in 1981. She is a native of Chillicothe, Ohio.

Corbett Grigsby -- Associate Head Coach

Corbett Grigsby enters his second year as the Lady Eagles' Associate head coach, but has been affiliated with Coach Laura Litter for the past 17 years, first as the athletic director and Litter's recruiting coordinator at Lees College from 1978 to 1989. After his stint at Lees, Grigsby and Litter moved on to Sullivan College from 1989-1997, where Grigsby took on the same responsibilities he held at Lees. At Morehead State, he will again direct the Lady Eagles' recruiting efforts.

Grigsby first entered into the coaching field in 1978 at Lees College. He served as athletic director when the women's basketball programs were begun at Lees and Sullivan, starting the team at Lees two years before the Litter's arrival.

During his stay at the two schools, Grigsby's teams compiled a 476-104 record.

In 18 years of coaching, Grigsby's squads have won 30 or more games six times and 20 or more 12 times. Ninety percent of the players he recruited at his two previous stops either graduated or transferred to a four-year school. Five of those athletes were also named as All-Americas.

James Black -- Assistant Coach

James Black returns for his second year as an assistant coach, having previously served as an assistant at Maryville College and Walters State Community College as well as a head coach at Roane State Community College. The veteran's primary duties at Morehead State will be coaching defense, strength and conditioning, and film breakdown.

Black joined the MSU staff after spending the 1996-97 season at Maryville in Maryville, Tenn., where he served under Kelli Casteel, who won two national championships as a player at Tennessee. The Lady Scots advanced to the "Sweet 16" of the NCAA Division III national tournament.

At Walters State, Black was an associate professor in the computer science department, while handling his coaching duties. He maintains a strong interest in computers.

During a three-and-a-half year playing career, Black was a starting shooting guard for Roane State (1977-79) and Lee College (1979-81), before an injury ended his career.
