### Attorney General OK's "Beer Shut-Off" Plan

QUESTION: "It would permissible, under the laws of any, for beer distributors to under a recement of understanding with each other to withhold the sale of beer from persons selling at retail who are violating the liquor laws, or any other laws of the state?"

ANSWER: "There is no restriction in inter the constitution or the Kentucky tatutes prohibiting the making of the kind of agreement referred to in the above question."—(signed) Jesse K. Lewis, Asst. Attorney General.

APPROVAL: "I have read and approve the above opinion, and will add that, in my opinion, the proposed form of agree-ment is valid and enforceable." (signed) Hubert Meredith, Attorney General.

This is official approval of the policy of the Kentucky Brewers and Beer Distributors Committee to shut off the supply of beer to those few retail outlets in the state that

violate the law, outrage public de and bring discredit to an industry pours into the treasury of this state than \$1,000,000 in taxes each year.
