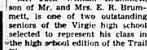


Arnulla Syck

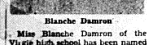


Maggie George

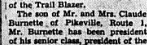
While in high school, Mr. Harmon has been a member of the Junior American Citizens club, the 4-H club, Pop club, Athletic club, English club, and Travel club.

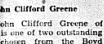

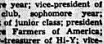

One of a class of sixty-one, Mr. Clark has been club president of the "D" club for four years; member of the Student Council for three years, and president, senior year.

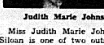


Jack Hiltchcock

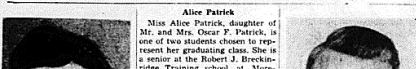
