

# DR. F. C. BUTTON

FORMER LEXINGTON MAN IS ELECTED PRESIDENT OF NEW STATE NORMAL SCHOOL AT MOREHEAD.

FRANKFORT, Ky., Sept. 1.—Dr. Frank C. Button, of Morehead, formerly of Lexington, rural school supervisor in the department of education, was elected president of the new normal school at Morehead today.

Dr. Button formerly was head of the school at Morehead before it was taken over by the State, but has been connected with the department of education for about 12 years.

The State Board of Education also adopted the course of study to be followed in the Morehead and Murray State normals and approved faculty members for the new teacher training institutions. Dr. John W. Carr, president of Murray State normal, was here today with his list of teachers, including Miss Mary W. Moss, W. M. Caudill, Aldine Yancey and E. H. Smith.

Dr. Button has selected Prof. Charles D. Lewis, now in charge of summer school work in Kentucky, to be dean and teacher of education at Morehead State normal. Other teachers approved for Morehead were Miss Inez F. Humphrey, Miss Evelyn Royalty, D. M. Holbrook, Warren Lappin and C. O. Pieratt.

Three classes of certificates will be given by the normal schools—elementary, intermediate and advanced, according to George Colvin, State superintendent. The courses of study will follow the lines used in Bowling Green and Richmond, according to Mr. Colvin. All the normals will have equal rank it was said.
