

Expanded Job Service For Veterans, Plan

An expanded job placement service for veterans was announced here today by Mrs. Lavinia Thurgill, manager of the Morehead Office of the United States Employment Service.

With specially trained personnel and a stream-lined procedure, the WACO's United States Employment Service plans to give quick service to the returning veterans. From the time the veteran enters a USES office he will be

given special attention. Streamlined procedure in the reception, interviewing job counseling and referral of veterans will be set up in the USES office, in order to give the returning veteran the best possible service.

"We believe we can give the veteran better service by handling veterans' placement through our regular office with these new special services," Mrs. Thurgill said. "We are stepping up our veterans' placement activities and cutting down the time which a veteran spends in the USES office."

We have a veterans' employment representative who is charged with this responsibility. We

will be prepared to advise veteran of job opportunities in various fields. The entire personnel is trained to carry on the work of interviewing and referring veterans to jobs. Our veterans' employment representative, who will assist in promoting the interest of veterans in the community and will work with employers to develop job orders for veterans on employers' orders.

"The first principle of the USES is to refer the best qualified man on an employer's order. The second principle is that if Veterans are not suited because we do not have suitable orders, the USES responsibility is to develop job openings. In this we seek the cooperation of all employers."

ADDRESS MAIL CORRECTLY—Navy Will Make Delivery

WASHINGTON, D. C. — The Navy is vitally interested in seeing that mail is delivered to all the boys in the service. That which is properly and properly addressed is quickly dispatched to its destination. Despite the hazards of war and weather, the Navy mail service has delivered letters to remote ships and stations with great efficiency. But—the mail must be addressed correctly.

Mail addressed to amphibious craft seems to give the most trouble. But if the sender addresses it properly, the Navy will get it through. In the first place, there are at least ten different types of craft—LST (Landing Ship, Dock); LSM (Landing Ship, Vehicle); LCI (Landing Craft, Infantry); LSM (Landing Ship, Medium); LST (Landing Ship, Tank); LST (Landing Craft, Support); and LCI (Landing Craft, Infantry—for more personnel).

Each type may have hundreds of different units numbering from 1 to 600. LCI No. 443 may be operating in the Pacific, whereas LST No. 443 may be in the Mediterranean. The letters "T" and "T" are often interchanged or are written so similarly that they are unreadable. If the "T" was mistaken for a "7", the letters would go far out of the way and the delay would easily be several weeks. Some are still under the impression that the Navy has one vessel called LST and they address their mail to the USL LST, Fleet Post Office, San Francisco. This is just the addressee mail to Main Street, U. S. A. In addressing Navy and Coast Guard personnel aboard ships print, don't write, his full name, rank or rate; print the name of his ship, L. S. LST Landing Ship,
