Conferred By the Kentucky University.

LONG LIST OF HONOR MEN.

CLOSE OF A SUCCESSFUL YEAR AT THE OLD SCHOOL.

MEN WHO WERE GRADUATED.

Lexington, Ky., June 9.—[Special.]—The commencement exercises of Kentucky University were held in Morrison Chapel yesterday morning. One young man received the degree of A. M., and eighteen young men and one young lady received the degree of A. B.; two the degree of B. L., and three the degree of B. S.

A pleasant and noteworthy feature of the day was conferring the honorary degree of LL. D. on Prof. Robert Graham, who has been an honored teacher in the university since 1859, and James Lane Allen, the distinguished author and one of the most famous of the university's alumni.

The new President, Reuben Lindsay Cave, showed himself worthy of the high position to which he has been called, and discharged the duties of his office most gracefully and creditably. Five States of the Union, Australia and Canada were represented in the graduating class. The alumni banquet was a most successful affair—the only disappointment being occasioned by the absence of the Hon. Champ Clark, of Missouri, who was to have delivered the alumni address, but who was unavoidably detained. Hon. C. J. Bronson made the principal speech.

The institution closed one of the most successful year's work in its history. There were 235 students in the College of Arts—an increase of thirty-five over last year. This is exclusive of the other colleges of the university—the entire attendance being six hundred and more. The following is the list of the graduates:
