1993 Kentucky Male Academic Athlete of the Year. Comes from Lafayette High School where coached by Donnie Harville.



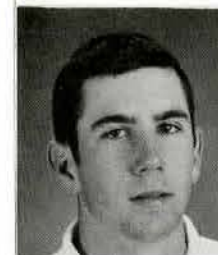
Kevin Childers

A graduate of Mason County High School and coached by Terry Prather and Mike Ross. 1993-1994 All-conference in baseball.



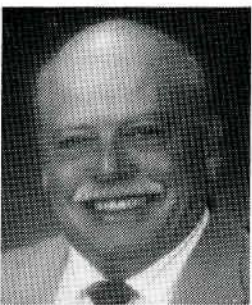


Dr. Rex Chaney
Head Coach

Entering his 22nd season as MSU's golf coach, Dr. Rex Chaney was voted OVC Golf "Coach of the Year" and led his Eagles to Ohio Valley Conference titles in 1977, 1981 and 1993 and runner-up in 1997.

Dr. Chaney's expertise in coaching is not limited to golf. He guided the Eagle baseball team from 1961 to 1965. In 1963, he won the OVC championship and was named OVC "Coach of the Year." He also served four years as assistant basketball coach under former head coach Bob Laughlin.

Coach Chaney holds a bachelor's and master's degree from MSU and a doctorate from Indiana University. Since 1961, he has been a faculty member of the MSU Health, Physical Education and Recreation Department. The 62 year-old is a native of Perry County, KY and is married to the former Sarah Kidwell of Bardstown, KY. They have one son, Lee.
