Staff Spotlight | Toni Hobbs



This section highlights a Staff Congress representative.

Toni Hobbs (Class of 2002, 2009), an Eastern Kentucky native, is the director of creative and branding services at Morehead State University. In April 2020, she was accepted into the Ph.D. in Arts Administration program at the University of Kentucky (UK). She holds a Master of Arts in Arts Administration from UK and a Master of Arts in Studio Art and a Bachelor of Arts in Art (Graphic Design), both from MSU. She is an illustrator and graphic designer who has exhibited nationally and internationally and has served as an MSU instructor since 2008. She was instrumental in developing the initial concept for a mentoring program for underrepresented students, DREAMS. She also established the Hobbs Endowment for Equality, a \$50,000 endowment fund committed to supporting academic scholarship and diverse programming at MSU, one of the first of its kind in Kentucky. Hobbs is a member of the MSU Visionary Society

and Circle of Excellence, providing leadership and financial support to further the University's mission. In addition to serving on Staff Congress and the Eagle Diversity & Inclusion Team, she is a member of the American Institute of Graphic Arts, Appalachian Studies Association, Association for Arts Administrators in Education, Association for Cultural Economics International, Consortium of Higher Education LGBT Resource Professionals, Council for the Advancement & Support of Education, Harvard Business Review Advisory Council, Honorable Order of Kentucky Colonels, Morehead-Rowan Co. Chamber of Commerce, National Coalition Building Institute, Omicron Delta Kappa Honor Fraternity, Project Management Institute and the University College Designers Association.
