### Librarian Attends Conference In Atlanta Oct. 11-14

### Miss Beat Watson, assistant librarian at Johnson-Camden Library, recently attended the 14th biennial conference of the Southern Library Association which was held from Oct. 11-14 in Atlanta, Ga.

The 750 delegates which attended the conference from Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee and Virginia. The conference had as its objective to promote more cooperation among librarians.

In the nine states represented there are about 24,000 people and libraries containing 1,500,000 books.

In 1947 the largest year for which complete reports are available in Washington, D. C. a total of \$4,500,000 for public library support. This amounts to 18 cents per person in the area represented. Throughout the year the Southern Library Association is hoped that the southeastern states will be able to improve their status.

The jump which Air Force Capt. Richard V. Wheeler, of Waterford, Mass., made from a height of more than 2,000 feet is believed to have set a new world's parachute drop record—exceeding by about 2,000 feet record of 40,200 feet set by Col. R.
