# July 1 Employee Compensation Increases:

- All full-time faculty and staff who have been employed full-time since September 1, 2021 will receive a one-time \$500.00 stipend in your mid-May payroll. If you do not receive it for some reason, please let the Payroll Office know and they will check it.
- Also, all full-time faculty and staff who have been employed full-time since September 1, 2021 will receive a base pay increase of 3% to their base salary beginning July 1, 2022. All full-time faculty and staff who were employed full-time *after* September 1, 2021 will receive a 1% increase to their base salary beginning July 1, 2022.
