MSTC Instructs Army Aviators

Two groups of ten trainees of the C. P. T. program, part of the tivil aeronautics program spon-nored by the government, have inished their ground school work and flight work on the Morehead ampus and have been sent on to econdary schools.

secondary schools. The program offered by More-head college in collaboration with the federal program includes ele-mentary courses covering a per-iod of eight weeks, during which time each cade is required to have a minimum of thirty-five fying hours for completion of the work.

The student trainees take their round work courses in the colc courses in the col-ms, and receive their lege classro flight instruction at the Licking Flying Field, at Farmers. In or-Fying Field, at Farmers. In or-der to do student flight work, each cadet secures a student plot's license and on the comple-tion of his training is eligible for a private plot's license. On completion of their elementary training at Morehead, the men are assigned to secondary train-ing centers located in the Co-lumbus district, at Springfield, Dayton, Columbus, Cheinsati, and Oxford, Ohlo.


