- Canned food

- Trash bags
- Work gloves

Should any member of our community wish to donate any of the above items, you may drop them off at our MSU Enrollment Services Building at the corner of 2nd Street and Tippet Avenue between today, Monday, August 1 – Friday, August 5 from 8 am - 4:15 pm. There is a roll-up shop door with collection bins there for easy drop-off.

Our staff will begin loading and delivering these to our partners late Friday and through the weekend.
