
On Thursday, the 1st inst., Craig Toliver and Mat Carey had a row in a saloon at Morehead, and Toliver was about to shoot Carey, but he managed to get away. On the following Monday writs were issued for the arrest of Toliver, Cook Humphrey, and Howard Logan. Toliver submitted to arrest, but when the Sheriff, Wm. Rainey, attempted to arrest the others, he was wounded, his son shot through the leg, and young Logan, resisting the arrest of his father, received a wound. Troops were telegraphed for, but the Governor refused to send them unless it became absolutely necessary.
