Purpose of the conference, possibly the first of its kind ever held, is to bring together representatives of the colleges and those high-school teachers who are directly concerned with the guidance of students about to graduate from high school.

The all-day conference will begin with registration at 9:30 a. m. in the Johnson Camden Library.

Topics which will be discussed include: guiding the senior in deciding to attend college; services which colleges can render to class sponsors; pre-professional college curriculum; opportunities for obtaining scholarships and awards; organizing and administering the Home Room program; financial planning; supervising senior class activities; planning for a "College Career Day" in the local school district; arranging for a "Senior Class Day" on the college campus; and social and recreational life on the campus.

## Trilogist Will Be At Breck To Give Lecture

James T. Farrell, Chicago-born novelist whose reputation is most firmly based on his Studs Lonigan trilogy, will present a talk at Breckinridge Training School, Monday, February 21, at 7:30 p. m.

The lecture is open to students, faculty and townspeople. Farrell's Studs Lonigan trilogy, completed in 1935, traces the career of its major character from his days as a pupil of a South Side Chicago high school (Young Lonigan) through his contact with the Chicago underworld which "lured" him into a life of crime and death (Judgment Day).

The trilogy is internationally known and has been reprinted in the Modern Library series as well as in paper-back editions. A note on Literary Criticism, several of novels based on a hero, Danny O'Neill, whose background is that of Studs Lonigan. A prolific writer, he has written other novels, including Bernard Clair, several volumes of short stories and a book of critical essays titled "A Note on Literary Criticism." Farrell's last published book, "Reflections at Fifty," appeared in late 1954. His major works are particularly noteworthy in their relationship of character to environment.

A number of his books are available in the college library. Following his lecture here, Farrell will visit Georgetown College and the University of Kentucky.

The Eagles gained revenge for an earlier defeat by soundly routing Georgetown Tigers, 95-77, at Morehead. A nip-and-tuck at the beginning, the score was tied 12 times during the first half before Morehead could move into a comfortable lead. Georgetown's earlier serious bid was with a 4:12 remaining in the first half, when the score was tied 41-35. From that point, the Eagles moved into a 46-39 halftime score mainly on the shooting of Dan Swartz and Jess Mayabb.

In the second half Donnie Gaunce and Bob Richards got hot and the Eagles began to pull steadily away from their much-tried opponents. Morehead made 20 out of 24 shots in the period for a phenomenal 59 per cent shooting average. The Eagles hit 59 per cent for the whole game.

Georgetown's gigantic center, "Tiny" Alexander, played a tremendous game for the losers as he led all scorers with 31 points, and accounted for 300 yards of the Tigers' rebounds by himself. Swartz, as usual, led the Morehead offense with 24 points, closely followed by Gaunce's 22. Mayabb, playing a guard position for the first time in the last two years as Coach Bob Laughlin attempted to get more height into the lineup, wound up the 19, Richards, with 17, and Hamilton, with 13, completed the Eagles' scoring.
