Cyberattack Update

Recently, Morehead State University experienced a cyberattack, which regrettably reflects a growing trend of such incidents targeting universities. During our ongoing repair and restoration efforts, we have come across indications that certain data may have been exposed. Our team is actively investigating the source and extent of this potential compromise. We are taking all necessary measures to identify and address the situation.

To ensure transparency, we are currently reaching out to twenty-one individuals that potentially could have data compromised. As of now, there is no evidence of any information being misused. However, we will keep those affected updated if we discover any misuse. If we determine in the future that any additional personal data was compromised, we will directly contact the affected individuals to provide them with notification. Our top priority has been to safeguard our campus through this recovery.

We are continuing to suggest that all individuals do the following for general technology security:

- Please consider changing your passwords for both MSU and non-MSU email, as well as other general accounts that you may utilize.
- Please continue to use two-factor authentication for on-campus accounts and consider this for your off-campus personal accounts if you are not already doing so.
- Be cautious of clicking on unknown links within emails or on the internet.
- Watch for unusual account activity.

For extra precaution and longer term, we are working with an off-campus firm (IDX) to begin offering free identity theft protection services for all employees and students. Information on this

will be sent to your home mailing address as well as electronically in a few weeks. This will add an additional layer of protection for our campus.
