Summary of the Most Recent Board of Regents Meeting:

- Approved revisions to the Student Code of Conduct
- Approved the OVC governing board certification
- Approved athletic director and coaching contracts

- Approved an operating budget amendment for the cyber security recovery
- Heard reports on 2023-2024 initiatives, 2024 employee health care, service contracts and real property leases
- Approved renovations of Nunn Residence Hall (all floors), Ginger Hall (a floor), minor work to Laughlin Health Building, and construction of a water mitigation area
- Approved razing Wetherby Gymnasium
- Presentation on a feasibility study for a new residential hall with a report at the next meeting
- Closed session for legal and security purposes

Wetherby Gymnasium:

Wetherby has served the campus well over the decades, but after years of use and storm damage to the roof we have begun the process of removing the building and using the area for student parking. Sometime later this fall the razing and removal process will begin, and in the spring/summer the paving process will begin. Our goal has been to create more main campus parking to get as many students as possible off the Hwy 60 overflow lots.
