Tuesday, January 16:

MSU's main campus will operate on Weather Plan C (a 2-hour delay). Offices will open at 10 a.m., and Tuesday classes will start at 11 a.m. This will allow a little extra time for individuals to access campus in the morning.

All classes will begin from 11 a.m. onward for the day, with no classes being held after 4 p.m. on Tuesday. Classes ending and offices closing at 4 p.m. will allow any individual who needs to return home before dark the ability to reasonably do so.

The MSU at Prestonsburg campus will be closed Tuesday with no classes.

Students, if you are unable to safely make it to campus on Monday or Tuesday, please send a message to your instructor(s) letting them know. If instructors are not able to make it to campus on Tuesday, they should send a note to all students in the class as soon as possible.
