It was Carplye who work "Genius is the-infinite capacity for taking pains." And it is that ability, that willingness of spirit which is even more important than manual dexterity or mental skills.

All work is as seeds sown; it grows and spreads like the ripples from a stone thrown into a pool. We do not know against what bank it may spend itself, or whom and what it may affect.

Slipshod work hurts first the doer. First in having to redo—for redoing work is staying in a rut, is not progressing or learning. Second, in the weakening of ability to do a job right. Carelessness is a habit-forming drug, insidious in its sapenjar of morale, but deadly in its effects.

The work that each of us do, the work that is before us, is our job, to be done by us. We must prove that we do it better than anyone else. But there is another thing to be remembered Dr. Stelzle brought it out in an article once years ago: "The day's work stands for a socialized effort, which has become possible only because others for the past have contributed their share to our effort. do not profess to know about construction costs, flood-wall maintenance or power dams. However, we will accept the engineer's own figures that the average flood damage to Morehead based on a period of 14 years, is \$36,400 annually Since the major flash flood during this period hit Morehead on July 4, 1939, we may reasonably conclude that damage here on that date was more than a quarter of a million dollars.

We are not immune from another flash flood —in fact the danger is greater because during the war most of the timber in the Triplett Valley has been cut making flood damage, particularly from flash floods, more imminent. Another flash flood hit Morehead tomorrow-next month-s year from now-or maybe through good luck it

year from now-or mayoe intough good may not come again for 10 to 20 years. The Army Engineers (and we use their figures) say that the cost of eliminating this finish flood horror would be twice the average report to so over the 14 years period when means in round figures that protection or Morehoad and vicinity would average aproximately \$52,000 a

The Army Engineers didn't mention the 39 lives that were lost in Morehead on July 4, 1939 when the waters of Triplett Creek, rising at the rate of a foot a minute, threw this town into a night of horror. No value was placed on these people—the plight of one Moreheadian who saw his wife and two children swept away in the muddy waters was not considered.

This report deals in dollars and cents. The loss of life in an Ohio River flood is negligible because the Ohio rises slowly and the people have ample warning. But, here at Morehead, when a flash flood comes, there is little or no warning and the swirling waters, falling from the mountain-sides in torrents, sweeps everything before it including human lives. 




