Approval of October 19, 2017 Meeting Minutes:

M. Hypes moved that the minutes for the October 19, 2017 University Graduate Committee meeting be accepted. V. Craig seconded the motion. All members approved. Motion carried.

Type I Proposal:

HPS 600 – Change course title to Research Methods in Kinesiology and Health. Department of Kinesiology, Health and Imaging Sciences, College of Science.

M. Hypes moved to accept the Type I proposal for the HPS 600 change in course title. T. Thornberry seconded the motion. All members approved. Motion carried.

Type III Proposals:

MA in Wellness Promotion – revision to admission requirements, assessment, and program. Department of Kinesiology, Health and Imaging Sciences, College of Science.

M. Hypes moved to accept the Type III proposal for the revision to the MA in Wellness Promotion with the modification on Page 9 changing the word “online” to “computer-delivered.” J. Fernandez seconded the motion. All members approved. Motion carried.

The following two Type III proposals were voted on collectively. Additionally, it was noted that the MPA program will investigate a way to reduce the required program credit hours by one course.

Master of Public Administration – addition of Concentration in Public Affairs Communication. Department of History, Philosophy, Politics, International and Legal Studies (HPPIL), Caudill College for Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences.

Master of Public Administration – addition of Concentration in Counseling and Addiction Services Management. Department of History, Philosophy, Politics, International and Legal Studies (HPPIL), Caudill College for Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences.

J. Fernandez moved to accept collectively the above two Type III proposals for the addition of two concentrations to the MPA program. V. Craig seconded the motion. All members approved. Motion carried.

Master of Music-Performance – addition of MUSW 610-Music Business as a required course in Performance concentration. Department of Music, Theater and Dance, Caudill College of Arts, Humanities, and Social Science.

E. Schack moved to accept the Type III proposal for the addition of MUSW 610 as a required course for the Master of Music-Performance. M. Hypes seconded the motion. All members approved. Motion carried.

Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT)–Special Education – reinstatement of program with minor changes. Department Early Childhood, Elementary, & Special Education (ECESE), College of Education.
